GOODS.—LOCAL RATES SCALE OF CHARGES.

Goods.—Local Rates Scale of Charges.

In pursuance of all powers and authorities enabling it under the Government Railways Act, 1926, and its amendments, the Government Railways Board hereby resolves to fix the following Local Rates and Scale of Charges for Goods, and to impose the following conditions and regulations in respect to the New Zealand Government Railways open for traffic; and the said Board hereby further resolves that such local rates and scale of charges and such conditions and regulations shall come into force on the 24th day of September, 1935, on which date all local rates, scales, conditions, and regulations previously made, fixed, or imposed in this behalf in respect to the said railways shall be revoked.

The following scales, conditions, and regulations may be cited as the Goods—Local Rates Scales of Charges, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the scales, conditions, and regulations fixed and imposed by resolution of the Government Railways Board on the 4th day of November, 1931, and therein cited, and hereinafter referred to, as the General Scale of Charges:—

The rates following will be charged upon the lines herein specified, instead of the classified rates set forth in the General Scale of Charges. Except as hereinafter provided, the regulations in the General Scale of Charges appertaining to goods and live-stock traffic will apply.

A special rate of 28s. per ton for butter and cheese consigned to Wellington from Papatawa, Woodville, Ngawapurua, Mangatainoka, Pahiatua, Mangamaire, Hukanui, and Newman shall be charged during the period hereinafter specified in lieu of the rates prescribed by paragraph I hereof, and from Eketahuna to Wellington in lieu of the rate prescribed by the General Scale of Charges, in cases where the person or persons having the management or control of the factory from which the butter or cheese shall be forwarded shall have given to the Board an undertaking in writing (such undertaking to remain in force until the 31st day of January, 1937) that the transport of all goods for or from the factory shall, unless otherwise agreed to by the Board with respect to any portion of such goods, be placed with the Board.
