The foregoing accounts have been examined and are certified with the following exceptions:-

1. The total of the balances as shown in the individual sub-accounts, which constitute the Public Account, amounting to £14,290,728 11s. 2d., is overstated owing to transfers made between sub-accounts being shown so as to increase the total balance of the borrowing sub-account without decreasing the total balance of the lending sub-account.

2. The credit balances shown as "Cash" in the individual sub-accounts, and which amount to £4,320,866 17s. 10d., are overstated by an aggregate amount of £1,128,000. The latter amount represents sums paid from the Public Account by way of investment, and was not held as "Cash" in the Public Account as shown.

3. An amount of £125,000 was paid during the half-year from the Public Works Fund, General Purposes Account, in respect of the purchase of 500,000 £1 shares of the Mortgage Corporation of New Zealand. Such payment is not shown as expenditure in the account, the amount being shown as a balance of the account at the end of the six months.
