THE following Proclamation was publicly made on the twenty-third day of January, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, in the front of Parliament Buildings, Wellington, in the presence of the Prime Minister and a large concourse of citizens:—

PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS it hath pleased Almighty God to call to His mercy our late Sovereign Lord King George the Fifth, of Blessed and Glorious Memory, by whose decease the Imperial Crown of Great Britain, Ireland and all other His late Majesty's dominions is solely and rightfully come to the High and Mighty Prince Edward Albert Christian

George Andrew Patrick David:

We, therefore, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, Michael Joseph Savage, Prime Minister of the said Dominion, and the Members of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, assisted by Members of both Houses of the General Assembly, Judges and Magistrates, Ministers of Religion, Mayors, Chairmen and Members of Local Bodies, and numerous other representative European and Maori citizens here present, do now hereby, with one voice and consent of tongue and heart, publish and proclaim that the High and Mighty Prince Edward Albert Christian George Andrew Patrick David is now, by the death of our late Sovereign of Happy Memory, become our only lawful and rightful Liege Lord Edward the Eighth, by the grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India: To whom we do acknowledge all faith and constant obedience, with all hearty and humble affection; beseeching God, by whom kings and queens do reign, to bless the Royal Prince Edward the Eighth with long and happy years to reign over us.

Given at Wellington in the Dominion of New Zealand, this twenty-third day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six.
