*Declaring a Bobby Calf Marketing Pool Area.*

**P**URSUANT to the Bobby Calf Marketing Regulations 1939, I, William Lee Martin, acting for the Minister of Marketing, being satisfied that a sufficient majority of the producers in the area of land defined in the Schedule hereto are desirous that such area should be declared to be a pool area for the marketing of bobby calves, do hereby declare such area of land defined as aforesaid, to be a bobby calf marketing pool area for the purposes of the said regulations under the name set out in the said Schedule, and I do hereby further declare that this notice shall take effect on the 29th day of August, 1939.

SCHEDULE.

BANKS PENINSULA BOBBY CALF MARKETING POOL AREA.

ALL that area of land lying entirely within the Counties of Wairewa and Akaroa and bounded by a line commencing at the point where the boundary-line between the Counties of Akaroa and Mount Herbert meets Big Bay on the northern foreshore of Banks Peninsula; thence continuing along the said boundary-line in a southerly direction to the point where it meets Trig. Station No. FF 32152; thence from this point taking a straight line across country to meet Trig.

Station No. KK 35075; thence from this point continuing a straight line across country in a southerly direction to meet Trig. Station No. D 6643 at Birdling's Flat; thence from this point continuing a line in a like direction to meet the southern foreshore of the peninsula; thence continuing along the said foreshore of the peninsula in an easterly, thence in a northerly, and thence in a westerly direction to the point where it meets the boundary-line between the Mount Herbert and Akaroa Counties at Big Bay, the original point of commencement.

regulations under the name set out in the said Schedule, and I do hereby further declare that this notice shall take effect on the 29th day of August, 1939.

SCHEDULE.

MOTUKARARA BOBBY CALF MARKETING POOL AREA.

ALL that area of land lying entirely within the Counties of Waiwera, Akaroa, Mount Herbert, Halswell, and Springs, and bounded by a line commencing at the farm occupied by C. Jones at the Birdling's Flats on the southern foreshore of the Banks Peninsula; thence taking a straight line across country generally in a northerly direction to meet Trig. Station No. KK 35075; thence from this point continuing a straight line across country in a north-easterly direction to the farm occupied by O. Bradley on the foreshore of Charteris Bay, Lyttelton Harbour; thence continuing along the foreshore of the said bay to the settlement of Allandale on the foreshore of Governor's Bay, Lyttelton Harbour, to and including the farm occupied by C. Jagger; thence from this point continuing a line in a westerly direction to the summit of the Port Hills crossing the Port Hill's Summit Highway and continuing down the spur of the hills to meet the Halswell River at Goodwins Bridge; thence following the Halswell River Canal to Hodgen's Bridge; thence from this point continuing along the Greenpark Road to and including the farm occupied by I. Harris; thence from this point, back to the point at Hodgen's Bridge; thence following the Halswell River Canal to its termination at Lake Ellesmere; thence continuing along the foreshore of the said lake in an easterly direction to meet Section 13, Block III, Waiwera Survey District; thence from this point taking a straight line to the coast-line facing the South Pacific Ocean, and from this point continuing along the said coast-line to the farm occupied by C. Jones at Birdling's Flat, the original point of commencement.
