Tenders for Inland Mail-service Contracts. — Blenheim, Christchurch, Dunedin, Greymouth, Invercargill, Nelson, Oamaru, Timaru, and Westport Postal Districts, 1941-43.

SEALED tenders will be received at the Chief Post-offices, Blenheim, Christchurch, Dunedin, Greymouth, Invercargill, Nelson, Oamaru, Timaru, and Westport, until noon on Monday, the 14th October, 1940, for the conveyance of mails between the undermentioned places for a period of three years from the 1st January, 1941.

POSTAL DISTRICT OF BLENHEIM.

1. Blenheim, Robinhood Bay, Ocean Bay, Hakahaka, Whangataura, Ngakuta, and Hakana, weekly.
2. Havelock, Brightlands, Elaine Bay, Saville's Bay, Te Towaka, Waitata Bay, Bulwer, Port Ligar, Forsyth Island, Wakatahuri, Te Puru, Okoha, Anakoha, Titirangi, Pohucui, Maud Island, Beatrix Bay, Clova Bay, Manaroa, Hopai, Eli Bay, Crail Bay, Homewood, and Havelock (part private bag delivery), twice weekly.
3. Havelock, Whatanihi, Palmer's, Pinohia, Maori Bay, J. H. Wells', Wells Bros., B. R. Paton, Roadley's, Hamilton, Tiraora, Te Rawa, A. R. Foote's, Pokokini, G. G. Wells, Yneyca Bay, Tamure, Nikau Bay, Neame's, Anderson's, Ohingaroa, Birch Nook, Brownlee's, and Havelock (part private bag delivery), twice weekly.

POSTAL DISTRICT OF CHRISTCHURCH.

1. Ashburton Railway-station and Post-office, as required.
2. Kaiapoi Railway-station and Post-office, five times daily.
3. Little River and Puaha: Little River along Main Road, Puaha Valley Road to Stackhouse's, retrace to Puaha, Harman's Track (Chapman's), retrace Harman's Track and Puaha Valley Road to Little River (rural delivery), daily. (Alternative to 4.)
4. Little River and Puaha: Little River along Main Road, Puaha Valley Road to Stackhouse's, retrace to Puaha, Harman's Track (Chapman's), retrace Harman's Track and Puaha Valley Road to Little River (rural delivery), thrice weekly. (Alternative to 3.)
5. Little River and Te Oka: Little River along Main Little River Road and Te Oka Road to Te Oka (rural delivery), twice weekly.
6. Rangiora Railway-station and Post-office, as required.

POSTAL DISTRICT OF DUNEDIN.

1. Alexandra-Earnsclough: Alexandra by Earnsclough and Blackman's Gully Roads to Kinnaird's Corner, returning to Earnsclough School, and along Clyde Main Road as far as Fraser River Bridge, then by Main and Earnsclough Roads to Alexandra (rural delivery), daily.
2. Alexandra-Roxburgh: Alexandra via Main Road to Fruitlands and Roxburgh and retrace to Alexandra (part rural delivery), thrice weekly.
3. Alexandra-Galloway: Alexandra, along Alexandra-Omakau Main Road, diverting to Galloway Road near Wallace's, thence to Galloway Railway-station corner, retrace to corner of River and Galloway Roads, thence along River Road, deviating by side road opposite Donaldson's to the Galloway Road, and returning to Alexandra (rural delivery), daily.
4. Balclutha Railway-station - Post-office, as required.
5. Bannockburn-Nevis, weekly.
6. Clinton-Wairuna :
 - (a) Clinton, via Main North and Ashley Downs Roads to W. Taylor's residence, Taumata School, returning to Clinton via Taumata Road; then via Main South, Brown's, and Old School Roads to Wairuna Siding, via Couston's, Madden's, and School Roads to Wairuna School, thence along Clarke's, Diver's and Popotunoa Roads to Clinton, daily.
 - (b) Clinton, Popotunoa Road to Popotunoa School, Clement's Corner, McHaffie's and Pomahaka River Roads to Swan's Corner, and return to Clinton via Popotunoa Road (rural delivery), thrice weekly.
7. Cromwell-Bannockburn, five times weekly.
8. Dunedin-Otakou :
 - (a) Dunedin, Macandrew Bay, Broad Bay, and Portobello, twice daily.
 - (b) Portobello and Otakou, thrice weekly.
9. Lauder-Becks: Lauder to J. Mee's gate, R. Hore's gate, retrace to Main Road, along Main Road to J. Beattie's, retrace to T. H. Mee's Road, along T. H. Mee's Road to J. Passmore's, to Armstrong's, to J. Hamilton's, R. Brown's, and T. A. Clouston's gates to Lauder (rural delivery), daily.
10. Middlemarch-Sutton: Middlemarch, along Mason's and Main Roads to junction with McKinnon's Road at Rock and Pillar, return along McKinnon's and Main Roads to Middlemarch, along Hospital Road and Brough's Road to H. E. Ward, to Gladbrook Station, along Dawson's Road to Main Road, along Main Road, Leckie's Road, and Farm Road to Main Road, and return to Middlemarch (rural delivery), daily.

11. Omakau-Matakanui: Omakau, along Racecourse Road to F. Donnelly's gate, along Smith's Road to Clouston's corner, along Matakani Road to D. Nevill's gate, retrace to Huddleston's Road, to W. Wilson's corner on Racecourse Road, along Drybread Road via Plews Hill to O. G. Glassford's, to Matakani Post-office, retrace to Wallington's Road, to J. Ball's, along White's Road to Scouler's Road to Scouler's and retrace to White's Road to Maclean's, to Ophir-Omakau Main Road, and return to Omakau (part rural delivery), daily.
12. Pembroke - Minaert Wharf: (Private bag delivery), fortnightly.

POSTAL DISTRICT OF GREYMOOUTH.

1. Awatuna Railway-station, Stafford, and Goldsborough, twice weekly. (Alternative to 4 and 6.)
2. Greymouth and Cobden (delivery of parcels, &c., within postmen's deliveries), daily.
3. Greymouth Railway-station, wharves, and Chief Post-office, as required.
4. Hokitika, Goldsborough, and Stafford, twice weekly. (Alternative to 1 and 6.)
5. Kumara Railway-station and Post-office, as required.
6. Kumara, Goldsborough, and Stafford, twice weekly. (Alternative to 1 and 4.)

POSTAL DISTRICT OF INVERCARGILL.

1. Gore: Delivery of parcels, daily.
2. Invercargill: Delivery of parcels in City and suburbs, daily.
3. Invercargill: Delivery of postmen's overflow bags, as required.
4. Invercargill Railway-station - Chief Post-office (including occasional trips to Railway Goods-yard Siding and Spey Street Railway Crossing), as required.

POSTAL DISTRICT OF NELSON.

1. French Pass, Waikawa Bay, Okouri Point, Pahakorea Bay, Otarawao, Wairangi, McLaren's Bay, Okiwi Bay, Croiselles, Greville Harbour, New Harbour, and Ohana Bay (private bag delivery), weekly. (Alternative to 4, 5, 6, and 7.)
2. French Pass, Whareatea Bay, Waitai, and Patuki (private bag delivery), weekly. (Alternative to 3.)
3. French Pass, Whareatea Bay, Waitai, Patuki, and Port Hardy (private bag delivery), weekly. (Alternative to 2.)
4. French Pass, Whareatea Bay, Waitai, Patuki, Port Hardy, Greville Harbour, New Harbour, Croiselles, Okiwi Bay, McLaren's Bay, Wairangi, Otarawao, Pahakorea Bay, Okouri Point, Waikawa Bay, and Ohana Bay (private bag delivery), weekly. (Alternative to 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, and 7.)
5. French Pass, Whareatea Bay, Waitai, Patuki, Greville Harbour, New Harbour, Croiselles, Okiwi Bay, McLaren's Bay, Wairangi, Otarawao, Pahakorea Bay, Okouri Point, Waikawa Bay, and Ohana Bay (private bag delivery), weekly. (Alternative to 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, and 7.)
6. Nelson, Okiwi Bay, Croiselles, McLaren's Bay, Wairangi, Otarawao, Pahakorea Bay, Okouri Point, Waikawa Bay, French Pass, Ohana Bay, New Harbour, Greville Harbour, Port Hardy, Patuki, Waitai, Whareatea Bay, French Pass (private bag delivery), weekly. (Alternative to 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7.)
7. Nelson, Okiwi Bay, Croiselles, McLaren's Bay, Wairangi, Otarawao, Pahakorea Bay, Okouri Point, Waikawa Bay, French Pass, Ohana Bay, New Harbour, Greville Harbour, Patuki, Waitai, Whareatea Bay, French Pass (private bag delivery), weekly. (Alternative to 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.)
8. Motueka, via Main Road to Riwaka Post-office, return to Packing Shed Corner, thence to end of Green Lane, retrace to Packing Shed Corner, thence via Hamilton's Corner to B. T. Rowling's, thence via Hydro Road to Creek, Shaggery Road, retrace to corner and along Hydro Road to G. H. Green's, retrace to Brooklyn School, thence to N. Lloyd's, Little Sydney, retrace to Hamilton's Corner, thence via Newport's Corner to D. Mickell's, Dehra Doon Road, retrace to Newport's Corner, thence along Main Road to G. Atkin's, retrace to Cook's Corner thence along Kaiteriteri Road to C. J. Tutbury's, thence via Main Road to Riwaka Post-office, retrace to Library Corner and along Green Tree Road to R. Drummond's, retrace and along Lodder's Lane to Wharf, return via Lodder's Lane and Main Road to Motueka (part rural delivery), daily.
9. Nelson Chief Post-office, Nelson East Post-office, Nelson South Post-office, Railway-station, Port Nelson Post-office and wharves; also delivery of parcels and overflow bags in Nelson postmen's delivery, as required.

10. Upper Moutere, Tasman, and Mapua (part rural delivery): Upper Moutere, along Rising Sun Valley to M. K. Henderson's and retrace traversing Ross's Road to junction Eggers' Road, along Main Road, Valley Hills, Harveys, Carlyons, Dominion and Main Roads to J. Coutts, retrace and via Main and Shaws Roads to Mapua Post-office, thence via Main Road to Tasman Post-office, thence via Baldwin's Road to Cole and Co.'s Depot, retrace and via Awa-Awa and Pomona Roads to Main Road at Ruby Bay, thence via Main and Gardiners Valley and Tarrant's Roads to H. Tarrant's, retrace, and along Gardiner's Valley Road to M. Bakers, thence to Upper Moutere, daily.
11. Upper Moutere - Waihero (rural delivery): Upper Moutere, along Main Road to Prices Corner and to D. Bensemans via Neudorf and Blackbird Valley Roads, retrace to junction of Neudorf and Rosedale Roads, thence along Rosedale Road to Rose Bros., retrace and via Prices Corner to Old House Road, thence along Old House Road to P. S. Williams, retrace and via Main Road and Flaxmore Road to B. Browns, retrace and via Main, Edwards, Central, and Drummonds Roads to A. R. Franklins, retrace and via Edwards and Waihero Roads to Greenwoods Corner, thence via Waihero and Central Roads to Cresswell Bros., retrace and via Waihero and McBrydies Roads to H. F. Kramer's, retrace and via Poly Bridge, Main and Waihero Roads to O. C. Best's Corner, retrace and to Lower Moutere School Corner, thence along Main Road to G. Flett's, retrace and via Mariri to Cole and Co.'s Store, thence to Upper Moutere via Harleys and Main Roads, daily.
12. Murchison, Upper Matakaitaki, Maruia, weekly.

POSTAL DISTRICT OF OAMARU.

1. Oamaru, delivery of parcels and overflow bags, as required within the postmen's delivery.
2. Oamaru Railway-station, Chief Post-office, and Breakwater, as required.

POSTAL DISTRICT OF TIMARU.

1. Temuka Railway-station and Post-office, as required.
2. Timaru: Delivery of parcels within boundary of postmen's deliveries, town area, twice daily; suburban area, daily.
3. Timaru Railway-station and Post-office:
 - (a) Timaru Railway-station, C.P.O., and vessels at wharf (also distribution of postmen's overflow bags), as required.
 - (b) Delivery of Hospital bag, twice daily.

POSTAL DISTRICT OF WESTPORT.

1. Westport, delivery of parcels within Borough boundaries, daily. (Alternative to 3.)
2. Westport, vessels in harbour, Railway-station, and Chief Post-office, as required. (Alternative to 3.)
3. Westport:
 - (a) Delivery of parcels within Borough boundaries, daily.
 - (b) Vessels in harbour, Railway-station and Chief Post-office, as required. (Alternative to 1 and 2.)

Forms of tender may be procured at any post-office.

The attention of tenderers is directed to the terms and conditions of contract printed at the back of the tender forms. Paragraph 1 referring to transport licenses should be given particular notice.

The attention of tenderers is drawn to the provisions of the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, with which the successful tenderer will be required to comply. On those routes affected the acceptance of the tender for the mail-service and the fulfilment of the mail contract will be contingent on the successful tenderer's obtaining a passenger or goods license for the route.

The attention of tenderers is expressly directed to clause 4 of the terms and conditions of contracts, which gives the Postmaster-General the right to fix the hours of departure and arrival. If a tenderer is not prepared to observe the existing time-table he is required to attach to his tender a copy of the time-table proposed.

It is to be clearly understood that all classes of mail-matter shall be conveyed by the contractor unless the conditions of tender contain a stipulation to the contrary in any respect.

No tender will be considered unless made on the printed form.

The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. Tenders are to be enclosed in sealed envelopes, enfaced "Tenders for Mail-service," and are to be addressed to the Chief Postmaster of the postal district to which the tender may specially refer.
