IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for post and telegraph purposes; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the fifteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Agreement for Grants of Easement in favour of William James Hogg and John Henry Hogg, both of Okoia, Farmers, over Land in Block VII, Ikitara Survey District, taken for the Wellington-New Plymouth Railway (Turakina-Okoia Deviation) assented to.

HEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 28th day of January, 1941, and published in the New Zealand Gazette No. 6 of 30th January, 1941, at page 129, all that piece of land containing 7 acres 0 roods 28.4 perches, being part Section 270, Block VII, Ikitara Survey District, was taken for the Wellington – New Plymouth Railway (Turakina–Okoia Deviation):

And whereas George Avener Hogg, of Wanganui, Albert Hogg, of New Plymouth, William James Hogg, of Okoia, and John Henry Hogg, of Okoia, all farmers, were entitled to compensation for their freehold interest in the said area of 7 acres 0 roods 28.4 perches:

Now, therefore, I, Hubert Thomas Armstrong, the Minister of Public Works, do hereby give notice, in pursuance of section 97 of the Public Works Act, 1928, that I assent to the agreement hereinbefore referred to.
