Vesting the Control of a Scenic Reserve in the Taranaki County Council.

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section thirteen of the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand doth hereby vest the control of the scenic reserve described in the Schedule hereto (being land reserved under the said Act) in the Taranaki County Council, subject to the conditions hereinafter contained, that is to say:—

1. The period for which the control of the reserve is hereby vested shall be five years from the date hereof, unless the reservation is previously altered or revoked under the said Act.
2. The said Council shall prepare a report each year ending on the thirty-first day of March, together with a statement of receipts and expenditure in connection with the said reserve. Such report and statement shall be sent to the Minister charged with the administration of the said Act as soon as possible after the close of the year.
3. The said Council shall control the said reserve in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the regulations made thereunder.

STONEY CREEK SCENIC RESERVE.—TARANAKI LAND DISTRICT.
SECTION 15, Block X, Cape Survey District: Area, 64 acres, more or less.

Vesting the Control of Scenic Reserves in the Raetihi Borough Council.

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section thirteen of the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand doth hereby vest the control of the scenic reserves described in the Schedule hereto (being lands reserved under the said Act) in the Raetihi Borough Council, subject to the conditions hereinafter contained, that is to say:—

1. The period for which the control of the reserves is hereby vested shall be five years from the date hereof, unless the reservation is previously altered or revoked under the said Act.
2. The said Council shall prepare a report each year ending on the thirty-first day of March, together with a statement of receipts and expenditure in connection with the said reserves. Such report and statement shall be sent to the Minister charged with the administration of the said Act as soon as possible after the close of the year.
3. The said Council shall control the said reserves in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the regulations made thereunder.

Lands temporarily reserved in the Marlborough and Otago Land Districts.

WHEREAS by the three-hundred-and-fifty-ninth section of the Land Act, 1924, it is enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time set apart temporarily as reserves, notwithstanding that the same may be then held under pastoral license, any Crown lands which in his opinion are required for any of the purposes in the said section mentioned:

Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the said Act, do hereby temporarily reserve the lands in the Marlborough and Otago Land Districts described in the Schedule hereunder written for the purposes specified at the end of the respective descriptions of the lands so intended to be temporarily reserved.

SCHEDULE.

MARLBOROUGH LAND DISTRICT.

ALL that land containing by admeasurement 2 roods 32.99 perches, more or less, situated in the Borough of Blenheim, being part of

Section 2, District of Otago, and being also Lot 19 on plan No. 1712, deposited in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Blenheim. (Recreation.)

OTAGO LAND DISTRICT.

All that area containing by admeasurement 2 acres 0 roods 15.24 perches, more or less, being part of Section 27, Sawyer's Bay District, and being all the land coloured sepia and orange on S.O. plan 9309. Bounded towards the north-west by a public road, 542.45 links; towards the north-east by Railway Reserve, 333.32 links; towards the south-east, north-east, and south-east by other part of Section 27, 155.69 links, 220.79 links, 387.26 links, 104.5 links; towards the north-west, south-west, and south-east by Railway Reserve, 128.67 links, 196.51 links, 310.84 links, 196.4 links; towards the south-west by other part Section 27, 200.23 links: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 6/9/73, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.
