The Lighting Restrictions Orders 1942, Amendment No. 2.

PURSUANT to the Lighting Restrictions Emergency Regulations 1941, the Dominion Lighting Controller doth hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Lighting Restrictions Orders 1942, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Lighting Restrictions Orders 1942* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Orders").
2. Order No. 1 of the principal Orders is hereby amended by inserting, after clause 5, the following new clause:—

"5A. Every provision of these Orders relating to premises shall bind persons in premises owned or controlled by the Crown, as well as persons in any other premises."

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken, and that the Crown land described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby set apart, for public works; and I do also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the sixteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two.

Revoking Part of a Proclamation taking Land for Road in Blocks XI and XII, Belmont Survey District.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke so much of the Proclamation dated the twenty-eighth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 28 of the third day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, at page 800, and deposited in the Land Registry Office at Wellington as No. 3073, taking land for road in Blocks XI and XII, Belmont Survey District, as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land being no longer required.
