Price Order No. 128, Amendment No. 2 (Eggs).

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,* the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following amending Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 128, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 128† (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Order”).

2. This Order shall come into force on the 12th day of April, 1943.

3. The Second Schedule to the principal Order, as set out in Price Order No. 128, Amendment No. 1‡, is hereby revoked and the following Schedule substituted therefor:—

Sawmilling Industry (Easter Holidays) Notice 1943.

NOTICE is hereby given that, in pursuance of the Industrial Man-power Emergency Regulations 1942, the Timber Controller hereby requires and directs as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Sawmilling Industry (Easter Holidays) Notice 1943.

2. Except with the prior consent of the Timber Controller every undertaking in the sawmilling industry shall in the week commencing on the 19th day of April, 1943, be operated until the usual closing-hour on Wednesday, the 21st day of April, 1943.

3. Except with the prior consent of the Timber Controller every undertaking in the sawmilling industry shall in the week commencing on the 26th day of April, 1943, be operated from a time which is not later than the usual commencing-time on Wednesday, the 28th day of April, 1943.

4. All notices previously given, or deemed to have been given, by the Timber Controller under the Industrial Man-power Emergency Regulations 1942, which have the effect of requiring any undertaking in the sawmilling industry to work any specified number of hours in each week shall not apply in respect of the weeks commencing on the 19th day of April, 1943, and the 26th day of April, 1943.
