**P**URSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,\* the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following amending Price Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 262, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 128† (herein-after referred to as "the principal Order").
