The Samos Land for Defence Purposes Order 1860

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

IN pursuance of the Samoa Act, 1921, and the Samoa Land Emergency Regulations 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

#### ORDER

This Order may be cited as the Samoa Land for Defence Purposes Order 1945.
 This Order shall come into force on the day following the

2. This Order shall come into the the day intowing the date of its publication in the Western Samoa Gazette.
3. (1) The Native land in Samoa described in the First Schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby taken for defence purposes and vested in His Majesty as from the date of the coming into force of this Order free from all estates, rights, and interests

of other persons therein.
(2) The agreements described in the Second Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be agreements between the persons entitled to compensation and the Administrator within the meaning of sub-clause (3) of Regulation 4 of the Samoa Land Emergency Regulations

4. The Crown land in Samoa described in the Third Schedule hereto is hereby set aside as a reserve for defence purposes.

5. The European land in Samoa described in the Fourth Schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby taken for defence purposes and vested in His Majesty as from the date of the coming into force of this Order, free from all estates, rights, and interests of any other person therein.

# FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that piece or parcel of land containing an area of 1,387 acres, more or less, situated at Satuimalufilufi and Satapuala, in the District of A'ana, described as part Parcel 97, Flur XV, Upolu, and more particularly shown bordered green on Plan 25 U/XVL, lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Apia.
