This amount is shown on the receipts side of War Expenses Account as "Reciprocal Aid" and, less proceeds of certain sales of these materials and stores, is included in the expenditure shown in the account against Navy, Army, Air, and Civil subdivisions. In this connection it is desirable to remark that (a) no relative payments have been made to or cash received from the United States or Canadian Governments, (b) values have been based partly on estimate.
