

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section fifteen of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

#### ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Education Districts (Southland and Otago) Adjustment Order 1945.

2. The boundaries of the Southland and Otago Education Districts (being contiguous education districts) are hereby altered as from the 1st day of January, 1946, by the exclusion from the said Southland Education District, and by the inclusion in the said Otago Education District, of the area of land described in the Schedule hereto. Schedule hereto.

#### SCHEDULE

All that area in the Otago Land District, being part of Lake County, bounded on the north and east generally by portions of the northern and eastern boundaries of Lake County; on the south generally by portion of the boundary of Lake County and the southern boundaries of Cardrona and Knuckle Peak Survey Districts; on the south-west and west generally by the south-western boundaries of Knuckle Peak, Motatapu, and Matukituki Survey Districts.
