*Revoking the Prohibition of Navigation of Aircraft over New Zealand*

A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section six of the Air Navigation Act, 1931, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the proclamation dated the twenty-second day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one\*, which prohibited the navigation of aircraft over New Zealand.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the Seal of that Dominion, this 24th day of December, 1945.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, and the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby authorize the Christchurch City Council to permit the laying-off of the proposed street described in the Schedule hereto of a width less than sixty-six feet but not less than forty feet, subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, and 14 of a subdivision of the land fronting the said street, as shown on the plan referred to in the Schedule hereto, within a distance of forty-eight feet from the centre-line of the said street, or on Lots 15 and 16 of the said subdivision within a distance of thirty-five feet from the centre-line of the said street.

WHEREAS by section thirty-one of the Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1928, it is enacted that the Governor-General, at the request of the Board of any rabbit district, may, by Order in Council, alter and redefine the boundaries of its district:

And whereas the district known as the Marlborough Coast Rabbit District has been constituted under and for the purposes of the said Act:

And whereas the Board of the said district has, pursuant to the said section thirty-one of the said Act, requested that the boundaries of its district be altered and redefined by excluding an area therefrom:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to alter and redefine the boundaries of the said district accordingly:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by the said Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby—

- (1) Alter and redefine the boundaries of the said district so constituted as aforesaid;
- (2) Declare that the boundaries of the said district shall be those set forth in the Schedule hereto; and, further,
- (3) Declare that this Order in Council shall come into force of the day following publication hereof in the *Gazette*.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF THE MARLBOROUGH COAST RABBIT DISTRICT

ALL that parcel of land in the Marlborough Land District containing approximately 57,600 acres, and bounded as follows: Commencing at the mouth of the Clarence River in Block XI, Puhipuhi Survey District; thence in a westerly, northerly, and north-easterly direction by the middle of the Clarence River to a point due west of the trig. station on Mole Hill, Block XVIII, Whernside Survey District; thence due east to the said trig. station; thence in a northerly direction by the watershed known as the Ladies Range and Front

Range to Trig. P on Ragged Robin, Block VIII, Wherside Survey District; thence in a westerly and north-westerly direction by the south-western boundary of Small Grazing-run 187 to the north-western corner of part Section 3, Block VIII aforesaid; thence in a westerly direction by a right line to the south corner of part Section 14, Block VIII aforesaid; thence generally in a north-easterly and north-westerly direction by the western and north-western boundaries of the said Small Grazing-run 187 to the source of the Nidd Stream; thence in a south-westerly direction by a right line to Trig. WH on Mount Wherside; thence in a north-easterly direction by a right line to the north-west corner of Section 4, Block IX, Wherside Survey District; thence in a south-easterly, easterly, and southerly direction by the north-eastern boundaries of the aforesaid Small Grazing-run 187; thence in an easterly and north-easterly direction by the northern boundary of Section 1, Block IX aforesaid, the western boundaries of Small Grazing-run 183A and the southern and western boundaries of Section 281, Block XVI, Cape Campbell Survey District, to the Ure River; thence in an easterly direction by the Ure River to a point due south of the westernmost corner of Section 1, Block X, Cape Campbell Survey District; thence due north to that corner; thence in an easterly direction by the northern boundary of the said Section 1 to Peg V on that boundary; thence in an easterly direction by a right line to the trig. station on Single Hill and its prolongation to the sea; thence in a south-westerly direction by the sea to the point of commencement.

*Exempting Crown Land from the Provisions of the Mining Act, 1926*

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General

**WHEREAS** by section twenty of the Mining Act, 1926, it is, *inter alia*, enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time, by notice in the *Gazette*, exempt any Crown lands from mining, or from any specified mining purpose, or from that Act, or any specified provisions of that Act, and that the lands to which any such notice relates shall be specified therein by words of particular description:

And whereas it is desirable that the Crown land specified in the Schedule hereto should be exempted from the provisions of the Mining Act, 1926, and its amendments, subject to existing registered mining privileges:

Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by section twenty of the Mining Act, 1926, and of all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling me in that behalf, do hereby exempt the land particularly described in the Schedule hereto from the provisions of the Mining Act, 1926, subject to existing registered mining privileges, and do also hereby declare that such exemption shall take effect from the date of the publication of this notice in the *Gazette*.

thence easterly along the southern boundary of that section, the abutment of a road, and again along the southern boundary of Section 3363; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of that section to a road; thence north-westerly along the eastern side of that road to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 2699; thence westerly across that road and along the southern boundary of the said Section 2699; thence northerly along the eastern side of a road to the southern corner of Reserve 1111; thence due east by a right line to the western boundary of Section 2700, Block XIV, Mawheraiti Survey District; thence generally in a northerly and easterly direction along the western and northern boundaries respectively of that section to the western side of a road; thence in a southerly direction along the western side of that road to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Section 2701; thence generally in a south-westerly direction along the north-western boundary of that section, the abutment of a road, and that line produced to the left bank of the Waipuna Creek; thence generally in a southerly direction along the left bank of that creek to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Section 2;
