**REVOCATION OF PROCLAMATION OF EMERGENCY AND
 OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS**

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Public Safety Conservation Act, 1932, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby revokes the Proclamation of Emergency made under the said Act on the 29th day of June, 1951,* and the Waterfront Strike Emergency Regulations 1951, and the amendments thereof, and hereby declares that the revocation of the said Proclamation and regulations shall not affect—

- (a) The validity, invalidity, effect, or consequences of anything already done or suffered ; or
- (b) Any existing status or capacity ; or
- (c) Any right, interest, title, or trust already acquired, accrued, or established, or any remedy or proceeding in respect thereof.

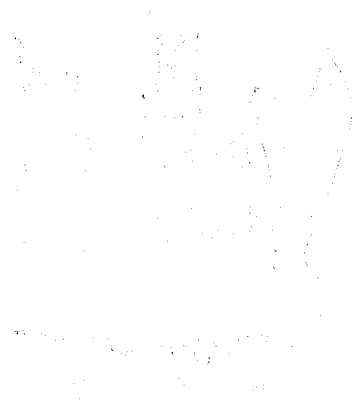
