the Proclamation: Now, therefore, pursuant to subsection (6) of section 5 of the said Act, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Auckland Education Board, as a site for a public school, shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen, freed and discharged from every educa-tional trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof. date hereof.
