HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

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WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Government Commission Act 1953, the Local Government Commission has approved as final a scheme bearing date the 2nd day of August 1955 providing for the area described in the Schedule thereto to be excluded from the County of Southland and included in the County of Clutha:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to give effect to the final scheme as hereinafter appearing:

Now, therefore, pursuant to the Local Government Commission Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares:

1. That, as on and from the 1st day of April 1956, the area described in the First Schedule hereto shall be excluded from the County of Southland and included in the County of Clutha:

2. That the boundaries of the Counties of Clutha and Southland as so altered shall be those set forth under the respective headings in the Second Schedule hereto:

3. That the area added as aforesaid to the County of Clutha shall be included in the Clinton Riding of that county:

4. That the boundaries of the Clinton Riding as so altered shall be those set forth in the Third Schedule hereto:

5. That the alteration of boundaries of the said counties hereinbefore made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Counties Act 1920.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

Area Excluded from County of Southland and Included in County of Clutha

ALL that area of land in the Southland Land District, Southland County, and bounded as follows:

Commencing at the junction of the Southland County boundary as described in Gazette No. 35 of 3 June 1954, page 949, and the southern boundary of part Lot 2 on plan numbered 3410 and deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Invercargill, at peg No. XIII; thence northwesterly and north-easterly generally and south-easterly along the southern, western, and northern boundaries of Lot 2 on the said plan numbered 3410, to and across the Mokoreta River to the north-western boundary of Lot 4 on plan numbered 3412 and deposited as aforesaid; thence northeasterly and south-easterly along the north-western and north-eastern boundaries of Lot 4 aforesaid, to a point on the Southland County boundary aforesaid at peg No. XLII; thence south-westerly by a right line to Trig. HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Government Commission Act 1953, the Local Government Commission has approved as final a scheme bearing date the 12th day of January 1956 providing for the abolition of the County of Kawhia, the alteration of the boundaries of the Counties of Otorohanga and Waitomo to include therein the area comprising the County of Kawhia, and the dissolution of the Kawhia Harbour Board, and making supplementary provision incidental thereto: incidental thereto:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to give effect to the final scheme as hereinafter appearing:

Now, therefore, pursuant to the Local Government Comission Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, eting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive mission Council, hereby declares:

- 1. That, as from the 31st day of March 1956, the County of Kawhia shall be abolished and the Kawhia County Council shall be dissolved.
- 2. (a) That, as on and from the 1st day of April 1956, the area described in the First Schedule hereto, being portion of the County of Kawhia, shall be included in the County of Otorohanga and shall form an additional riding of that county by the name of the Kawhia North Riding.
- (b) That the boundaries of the County of Otorohanga as so altered shall be those described in the Second Schedule hereto.
- (c) That the Kawhia North Riding of the County of Otorohanga shall be represented on the council of that county by one member and for that purpose the number of members of that council shall be increased, as on and from the 1st day of April 1956, from seven to eight.
- 3. (a) That, as on and from the 1st day of April 1956, the area described in the Third Schedule hereto, being the remainder of the County of Kawhia, shall be included in the County of Waitomo and shall form an additional riding of that county by the name of the Kawhia South Riding.
- (b) That the boundaries of the County of Waitomo as so altered shall be those described in the Fourth Schedule hereto.
- (c) That the Kawhia South Riding of the County of Waitomo shall be represented on the council of that county by one member and for that purpose the number of members of that council shall be increased, as on and from the 1st day of April 1956, from nine to ten.
- 4. That the first election of the member to represent the Kawhia North Riding on the Council of the County of Otorohanga and the first election of the member to represent the Kawhia South Riding on the Council of the County of Waitomo shall be held on the day fixed by law for the next triennial general election of members of County Councils.
- 5. That, until the members elected as aforesaid come into office, one member of the Kawhia County Council, to be chosen by that council, shall represent the Kawhia North Riding on the Council of the County of Otorohanga and a further member of the Kawhia County Council, to be chosen by that council, shall represent the Kawhia South Riding on the Council of the County of Waitomo. For the purpose of choosing those representatives, but for no other purpose, the Kawhia County Council may continue in office after the 31st day of March 1956.
- 6. That, as on and from the 1st day of April 1956, the Kawhia Harbour Board shall be dissolved.

Price Order No. 1648, New Zealand Lemons (Other Than Meyer Lemons)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price

Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:

1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 1648, and shall come into force on the 26th day of March 1956.

2. (1) Price Order No. 1640\* is hereby revoked.

(2) The revocation of the said price order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this order.

#### APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

3. (1) This order applies with respect to all New Zealand grown lemons (other than Meyer lemons) sold by way of retail.

(2) The provisions of this order as to maximum retail prices shall apply notwithstanding that any such lemons are sold otherwise than by weight.

#### MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES

- 4. (1) Subject to the provisions of this clause, the maximum retail price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any lemons to which this order applies shall be computed as follows:
  - (a) For lemons sold at any place in the North Island north of a straight line drawn from Tirau Point on the West Coast to Young Nick's Head on the East Coast: At the rate of 1s. 6d. per pound.

    (b) For lemons sold elsewhere in the North Island: At the rate of 1s. 7d. per pound.

    (c) For lemons sold in the South Island: At the rate of 1s. 8d. per pound.
- (2) If in respect of any lot of lemons sold by a retailer the maximum price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause is not an exact number of pence or halfpence, the maximum price of the lot shall be computed to the next upward halfpenny.
- (3) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this order, and subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any retailer, may authorise special maximum prices in respect of any lemons to which this order applies where special circumstances exist or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this subclause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of lemons or may relate generally to all lemons to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force.

#### DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS

5. Every retailer who offers or exposes any such lemons for sale in any shop shall keep in a prominent position in such proximity to the lemons to which it relates as to be obviously descriptive thereof a ticket, placard, or label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the retail price per pound of the lemons.

#### APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

4. This order applies with respect to all sales in New Zealand, whether wholesale or retail, of eggs of domestic fowls

#### CLASSIFICATION OF EGGS FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ORDER Hen Eggs

- 5. (1) For the purposes of this order, every lot of hen eggs sold by a producer, or wholesaler, or retailer shall be classified as "Large Grade", "Standard Grade", "Medium Grade", "Pullet Grade", or "Mixed".
- (2) With respect to hen eggs that have been graded in accordance with the Egg Marketing Authority Regulations 1953, the classification of such eggs for the purposes of this order shall correspond to the grading under those regulations.
- (3) With respect to hen eggs that have not been graded in accordance with the said regulations, the following special provisions shall apply:

  - (a) Any lot of eggs sold or offered for sale may be classified for the purposes of this order as "Large Grade", "Standard Grade", "Medium Grade", or "Pullet Grade" as the case may be if all the eggs in the lot would be of the corresponding grade if they had been graded under the said regulations.

    (b) Any lot of eggs sold or offered for sale consisting of eggs which, if graded under the said regulations, would be graded in more than one grade shall be classified for the purposes of this order as "Mixed Eggs": Provided that if the average weight of the eggs in the lot is less than 2 oz. the lot shall be classified as "Pullet Grade" eggs.

#### Duck Eggs

- 6. (1) For the purposes of this order, every lot of duck eggs sold by a producer, wholesaler, or retailer shall be classified as "Large", "Small", or "Mixed".
  - (2) With respect to the classification of duck eggs-

  - (2) With respect to the classification of duck eggs—
    (a) All eggs of a weight not less than 2 3 6 oz. shall be classified as "Large".
    (b) All eggs of a weight less than 2 3 oz. shall be classified as "Small".
    (c) If any lot of eggs comprises some eggs classifiable as "Large" and some classifiable as "Small" all the eggs in the lot shall be classified as "Mixed".

# FIXING MAXIMUM WHOLESALE PRICES OF EGGS TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES

- 7. (1) The price that may be charged or received by any wholesaler (including a producer selling otherwise than by way of retail) for any eggs to which this order applies shall not exceed the appropriate maximum price specified in the First Schedule hereto.
- (2) Every wholesaler (including a producer selling otherwise than by way of retail) who sells any eggs to which this order applies shall specify in the relevant invoices with respect to each item the classification of the eggs comprised in the

# FIXING MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF EGGS TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES

8. The maximum retail price that may be charged or received by any retailer (including a producer) for any eggs to which this order applies shall be the appropriate maximum price specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

#### Retailers to Exhibit Prices

9. Every retailer who offers or exposes any eggs to which this order applies for sale in any shop shall keep in a prominent position in such proximity to the eggs to which it relates as to be obviously descriptive thereof a ticket, placard, or label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the classification of the eggs according to whether they are "Large Grade", "Standard Grade", "Medium Grade", "Pullet Grade", or "Mixed" (in the case of hen eggs), or "Large", "Small", or "Mixed" (in the case of duck eggs), and the retail price per dozen of the eggs.

# FIXING MAXIMUM WHOLESALE AND RETAIL PRICES FOR LOOSE CHILLED HEN EGGS TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES

10. The maximum wholesale or retail price that may be charged or received by any wholesaler or retailer for loose chilled hen eggs to which this order applies shall be the appropriate maximum price specified in the schedules hereto reduced by 6d. per dozen.

#### PROVISION FOR SPECIAL PRICES

11. Subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any wholesaler or retailer, may authorise special maximum prices in respect to any eggs to which this order applies, where special circumstances exist, or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the wholesaler or retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of eggs, or may relate generally to all eggs to which this order applies sold by the wholesaler or retailer while the approval remains in force.
