Pursuant to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following amending Price Order:

- 1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 1652, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 1649* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
 - 2. This order shall come into force on the 23rd day of April 1956.
 - 3. The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the First and Second Schedules thereto, and substituting the following Schedules:

Declaring Maori Land to be Crown Land

[L.S.] C. W. M. NORRIE, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

DURSUANT to section 263 of the Maori Affairs Act 1933, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land and to be subject to the Land Act 1948.

SCHEDULE

SOUTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL that piece of land containing 365 acres, more or less, known as the Whangamata No. 681 Block, situated in Block VII, Ohinemuri Survey District, being all the land in certificate of title, Volume 348, folio 242, Auckland Registry, as shown on the plan numbered M.L. 3836A lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Auckland.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General, and issued under the Seal of New Zealand, this 22nd day of March 1956.
