PURSUANT to the Local Government Commission Act 1953, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares:

1. That, as on and from the 1st day of April 1958, the area described in the First Schedule hereto shall be included in the Omarunui Drainage District.

2. That the boundaries of the Omarunui Drainage District as so altered shall be as defined in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. That the alteration of the boundaries of the said district hereinbefore made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Land Drainage Act 1908.

FIRST SCHEDULE

AREA INCLUDED IN OMARUNUI DRAINAGE DISTRICT

ALL that area in the Hawke's Bay Land District containing 180 acres, more or less, situated in Block X, Heretaunga Survey District, and bounded as follows:
