COBHAM, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Warrant published in *Gazette*, 21 February 1929, Volume I, page 445, relating to the Wellington Acclimatisation District notifying and declaring certain areas to be sanctuaries under the Animals Protection and Game Act 1921–22, to the extent appearing in the Schedule hereto.
