(e) Professional tipsters, persons convicted of house breaking or pocket-picking, forgery, uttering or possessing counterfeit coin, theft, false pretences, receiving stolen goods, mischief, assault or any offence or crime of any kind under the Crimes Act 1908, and also idle and disorderly persons, rogues and vagabonds, and incorrigible rogues convicted under the Police Offences Act 1908, and persons convicted of an offence under the Gaming Act 1908. The number of insertions required must be written across the face of the advertisement.

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Under the Regulations Act 1936, statutory regulations of general legislative force are no longer published in the New Zealand Gazette, but are supplied under any one or more of the following arrangements:

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 (3) Separate regulations as issued.

The price of each regulation is printed thereon, facilitating the purchase of extra copies.
