Price Order No. 1780 (Laying Mash and Chick Mash)

Pursuant to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following price order:

PRELIMINARY

- 1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 1780, and shall come into force on the 14th day of August 1959.
- 2. (1) Price Order No. 1774* is hereby revoked.
- (2) The revocation of the said order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this order.
 - 3. In this order:
 - "Auckland Metropolitan Area" means the City of Auckland, the Boroughs of Birkenhead, Devonport, Ellerslie, Mount Albert, Mount Eden, Mount Roskill, Mount Wellington, New Lynn, Newmarket, Northcote, Onehunga, One Tree Hill, Otahuhu, and Takapuna.

"Wellington Metropolitan Area" means the Cities of Wellington and Lower Hutt, the Boroughs of Eastbourne and Petone. "Christchurch Metropolitan Area" means the City of Christchurch and the Boroughs of Riccarton and Lyttelton. "Dunedin Metropolitan Area" means the City of Dunedin and the Boroughs of Green Island, Port Chalmers, St. Kilda, and West "Standard mash" means laying mash or chick mash that has been manufactured to conform to the formula set out in the First Schedule

"Standard mash" means laying mash or chick mash that has been manufactured to conform to the formula set out in the Flist Schedule to this order.

"Merchant" means a person who in the customary course of his business sells mash both to retailers and to consumers, and with respect to sales made by a manufacturer to a retailer or to a consumer, includes a manufacturer.

"Retailer" means a person who sells mash only to consumers.

"Ton" means 2,000 lb.

"Bushel" means 20 lb.

The expression "f.o.r." means "free on rail", and the expression "f.o.b." means "free on board".

"Delivered" means delivered to the premises of the purchaser.

APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

4. This order applies with respect to any poultry food sold as mash in New Zealand except Basic Poultry Ration or other poultry foods to which Price Order No. 1773 (or any amendment thereof or new price order in substitution therefor) applies.

FIXING MAXIMUM PRICES OF MASH TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES

Manufacturers' Prices

- 5. (1) Subject to the following provisions of this order, the maximum price that may be charged or received by any manufacturer carrying on business at one of the places specified in the Second Schedule hereto for any standard mash to which this order applies shall be the appropriate price specified in the said Schedule, and with respect to any other mash shall be the appropriate price fixed for No. 1 laying mash or No. 1 chick mash (as the case may be) reduced at the rate of £7 per ton, unless a price order or a special approved price is in force with respect to such mash.
- (2) Subject to the following provisions of this order, the maximum price that may be charged or received by any manufacturer carrying on business elsewhere than at one of the places specified in the Second Schedule hereto for any mash to which this order applies shall be the price that may be charged by the manufacturer carrying on business at the nearest specified place increased by the amount of the freight charges that would have been incurred had the mash been conveyed at current rates from such nearest place to the premises of the manufacturer.
 - (3) The prices fixed by the foregoing provisions of this clause are fixed as for delivery at the premises of the manufacturer.

Merchants' Prices

- 6. (1) Subject to the following provisions of this order, the maximum price that may be charged or received by any merchant carrying on business at one of the places specified in the Second Schedule hereto for any standard mash to which this order applies shall be the appropriate price specified in the said Schedule, and with respect to any other mash shall be the appropriate price fixed for No. 1 laying mash or No. 1 chick mash (as the case may be) reduced at the rate of £7 per ton, unless a price order or a special approved price is in force with respect to such mash.
- (2) Subject to the following provisions of this order, the maximum price that may be charged or received by any merchant carrying on business elsewhere than at one of the places specified in the Second Schedule hereto for any mash to which this order applies shall be the price that may be charged by the merchant carrying on business at the nearest specified place increased by the amount of any freight charges actually incurred between the place of purchase and the merchant's store.

Retailers' Prices

- 7. (1) Subject to the following provisions of this order, the maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer carrying on business at one of the places specified in the Second Schedule hereto for any standard mash to which this order applies shall be the appropriate price specified in the said Schedule, and with respect to any other mash shall be the appropriate price fixed for No. 1 laying mash or No. 1 chick mash (as the case may be) reduced at the rate of £7 per ton, unless a price order or a special approved price is in force with respect
- (2) Subject to the following provisions of this order, the maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer carrying on business elsewhere than at one of the places specified in the Second Schedule hereto for any mash to which this order applies shall be the lesser of (a) the price that may be charged by a retailer carrying on business at the nearest specified place increased by the appropriate proportion of any freight charges actually incurred between that place and the retailer's store, or (b) the price that may be charged by a retailer carrying on business in the specified place from which the mash was purchased, increased by the appropriate proportion of any freight charges actually incurred between that place and the retailer's store.

GENERAL

- 8. (1) The prices fixed by the foregoing provisions of this order are fixed with respect to mash packed in sacks of the following sizes: 48 in. by 23 in., 46 in. by 23 in., and 41 in. by 23 in.
- (2) Where any mash is packed in sacks or bags of any other size the said prices shall be reduced by 12s. 6d. per ton unless a different price is specially authorised under the provisions of clause 9 of this order.
 - (3) The prices fixed by this order are net and include the cost of the sacks or bags.

PROVISION FOR SPECIAL PRICES

- 9. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this order, and subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any manufacturer, merchant, or retailer, may authorise special maximum prices in respect of any mash to which this order applies where special circumstances exist or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the manufacturer, merchant, or retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of mash, or may relate generally to all mash to which this order applies sold by the manufacturer, merchant, or retailer while the approval remains in force. the approval remains in force.
- 10. Where the price computed in accordance with the provisions of this order is, in the case of a manufacturer or merchant, not an exact number of pence, it may be computed to the next upward penny, and where, in the case of a retailer, it is not an exact number of pence or halfpence, it may be computed to the next upward halfpenny.

DUTY IMPOSED ON VENDORS OF MASH

11. Every vendor of mash to which this order applies shall state, in the appropriate invoice relating to the sale, the kind of mash to which the sale relates, that is to say, whether it is No. 1 or No. 2 laying mash, No. 1 or No. 2 chick mash, or mash that is other than standard mash.

Price Order No. 1781 (Cheese)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following price order:

PRELIMINARY

1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 1781, and shall come into force on the 14th day of August 1959.
2. (1) Price Order No. 1752* is hereby revoked.
(2) The revocation of the said Price Order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this order.

3. (1) In this order, unless the context otherwise requires,—
"The said Act" means the Control of Prices Act 1947:
"The said regulations" mean the Dairy Produce Regulations

"Export size", in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 80 lb. (rinded) or 60 lb. (rindless):

"Medium size", in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 40 lb.:

"Pancake size", in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 20 lb.:

"Daisy size", in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 25 lb.:

"Loaf size", in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 25 lb.:

"Standard lot", in relation to a transaction for the sale of cheeses, means a lot consisting of two cheeses of export size, or three cheeses of medium size, or six cheeses of pancake size, or five cheeses of daisy size, or nine cheeses of loaf size (rindless):

"Manufacturing dairy" means a dairy registered as a cheese factory, pursuant to the said regulations.

factory, pursuant to the said regulations.

(2) Terms and expressions defined in the said Act, or in the said regulations, when used in this order, have the meanings severally assigned thereto by the said Act or by the said regulations as the case may be.

regulations as the case may be.

4. For the purposes of this order, any person who sells by retail to any one purchaser, for delivery at any one time, not less than three standard lots of export size, medium size, pancake size, daisy size, or loaf size cheeses, whether or not all the standard lots contain the same size of cheeses, shall in respect of that sale be deemed to be a wholesaler, and the provisions of this order as to maximum wholesale prices shall apply accordingly with respect to every such sale.

APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

5. (1) Except as otherwise provided herein this order applies with respect to all sales in New Zealand by way of wholesale, or retail, of Cheddar cheese that is sold by a wholesaler or retailer, as the case may be, within four months after the

date of its manufacture.

(2) For the purposes of this clause the date of the manufacture of any cheese shall be deemed to be the date indicated

on the cheese in accordance with the requirements of the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938†.

(3) Every person who sells any Cheddar cheese by retail (whatever the age of such cheese) shall keep, for a period of not less than four months, a record showing the date of the delivery of the cheese to the retailer, and also—

(a) If the whole cheese was sold, without cutting, the date

of its sale; or
(b) In any other case, the date on which the cheese was

(4) In its application to sales by wholesalers, this order applies only to the sale of export size, medium size, pancake size, daisy size, and loaf size cheeses.

(5) In its application to sales by retailers, this order applies to the sale of all Cheddar cheese referred to in subclause (1) of this clause sold by retail.

Provided that if a wholesaler cuts portions from a whole export or a whole medium cheese for sale by way of wholesale he may add to the appropriate maximum price (computed in accordance with the foregoing table) that may be charged or received for such whole cheese the sum of ½d. per pound.

Provided further that for the purposes of this order the cutting of a cheese does not alter the classification of such cheese as set out in clause 3 (1) of this order.

- (2) For the purposes of this clause the weight of any cheeses, other than those sold in crates and cartons, shall be deemed to be their actual weight when delivered to the purchaser, and the weight of cheeses sold in crates or cartons shall be deemed to be their weight as at the time of placing in crates or cartons.
- 7. Notwithstanding anything in clause 6 of this order, the maximum prices that may be charged or received for any cheese to which this order applies by any manufacturing dairy upon any sale to a wholesaler shall be \(\frac{1}{4}\)d. per pound less than the prices computed in accordance with the said clause.

RETAILERS' PRICES

- 8. (1) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any cheese to which this order applies shall be determined in accordance with the following provisions, namely:
 - (a) In the case of cheese sold by a retailer to whom supplies of Cheddar cheese are available, free of freight charges, for delivery at his store from any source whatever, the maximum retail prices shall be: (i) Loaf size 2s. $1\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pound, and (ii) All other sizes ' 1s. $11\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pound.
 - (b) In cases to which the last preceding paragraph does not apply, the maximum retail prices shall be:
 - (i) Loaf size 2s. $1\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pound, and
 - (ii) All other sizes 1s. $11\frac{1}{2}d$. per pound increased to the next upward halfpenny by the appropriate proportion of the freight charges incurred by the retailer in obtaining delivery at his store:

Provided that where any cheese to which this paragraph applies is obtained by the retailer from a source of supply that is not the most convenient of access to the retailer's store, the increase of the price per pound authorised by this paragraph shall not exceed the appropriate proportion of the freight charges that would have been incurred by the retailer if the cheese had been obtained from the source of supply most convenient of access to his store, and if delivery had been effected by a common carrier at current freight rates.

- (2) Where the quantity of cheese sold by a retailer in any one transaction is not an exact number of pounds, the maximum price shall be computed at the rate per pound fixed in accordance with the last preceding subclause.
- (3) If in respect of any cheese the retail price charged in accordance with the provisions of this clause is not an exact number of pence or halfpence, the maximum price shall be computed to the next upward halfpenny.

FREIGHT CHARGES

9. Any cheese, sold in pursuance of clause 6 of this order by a manufacturing dairy to a wholesaler, shall be delivered freight free to the nearest railway station to the purchaser's premises, or to the point of delivery to which it is customarily

SPECIAL PRICES WHERE EXTRAORDINARY CHARGES INCURRED

10. Subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any retailer, may authorise special prices in respect of any cheese to which this order applies where special circumstances exist or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of cheese or may relate generally to all cheese to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force.
