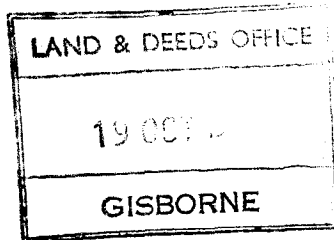

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 23 of the Counties Act 1956, the Makara County Council hereby resolves, by way of special order, as follows:

1. The present division of the County of Makara into four ridings, namely, Makara, Ohariu, Belmont, and Porirua is hereby revoked, and in lieu thereof the said county shall be divided into two ridings, to be called respectively, Makara Riding and Porirua Riding, which said ridings are separately described in the Schedule hereto.

2. The alterations hereby made shall take effect on and after the 19th day of October 1959.
