Varying a Proclamation Declaring Parts of New Zealand to be a Tribal District Under the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945

### A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 6 (2) of the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby vary a Proclamation dated 2 February 1957 and published in the Gazette on 14 February 1957, Volume I, page 205, declaring parts of New Zealand to be tribal districts under the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945, by deleting from the Schedule thereto the description of the Orimupiko Tribal District and substituting therefor the description appearing in the Schedule hereto.

And whereas, by notice issued by the Governor on the 27th day of August 1953<sup>‡</sup>, Harold Ruegg, Esquire, was appointed an officer of the Government of the Dependency and vested with the powers and authorities described in the said notice, and in particular with the general executive and administrative authority in preserving Her Majesty's rights and sovereignty and the laws and regulations in force in the Dependency:

And whereas it is expedient that the persons hereinafter named be also appointed officers of the Government of the Dependency:

Now, therefore, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, and as such the Governor of the Ross Dependency, hereby appoint

Lieutenant-Commander James Lennox-King, v.R.D.,
