Declaring Land to be Crown Land

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 265 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land and to be subject to the Land Act 1948.

SCHEDULE

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL that piece of land containing 40 acres 1 rood 30 perches, more or less, being the block of land known as Ketetangariki B 2c Block situated in Block III, Tutamoe Survey District. (M.L. Plan 10702.)

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 6 of the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, do hereby declare the parts of New Zealand described in the First Schedule hereto to be tribal districts for the purpose of the said Act, with the respective names therein set out, and do hereby revoke the earlier Proclamations enumerated in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

KAIPARA TRIBAL DISTRICT

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, Counties of Waitemata and Rodney and the Borough of Helensville, bounded by a line commencing at the South Head of the Kaipara Harbour and proceeding southerly, easterly, and northerly generally along the shore of the Kaipara Harbour to the mouth of the Hotoe River in Block X, Tauhoa Survey District; thence south-easterly along a right line to the north-western corner of part Section 134, D.P. 2543, in Block XIII, Mahurangi Survey District; thence southerly along the Waitemata County boundary as described in *Gazette*, 1957, page 1295, to the southernmost corner of Allotment S.W. 110, Parish of Puhoi in Block I, Waiwera Survey District; thence southerly along a right line to Trig. Station E in Block XIII,

Waiwera Survey District; thence westerly along a right line to the south-western corner of Lot 1, D.P. 9424, being part of Paeroa No. 1 Block in Block III, Kumeu Survey District, and its production to the sea coast; thence northerly generally along the shores of the Tasman Sea and the entrance to the Kaipara Harbour to the point of commencement.

WAITEMATA TRIBAL DISTRICT

All that area in the North Auckland Land District, the County of Waitemata, the City of Auckland, the Boroughs of Birkenhead, Devonport, East Coast Bays, Ellerslie, Glen Eden, Henderson, Mount Albert, Mount Eden, Mount Roskill, Mount Wellington, New Lynn, Newmarket, Northcote, Onehunga, One Tree Hill, Otahuhu, and Takapuna, commencing at the southernmost corner of Allotment S.W. 110, Parish of Puhoi in Block I, Waiwera South District, and proceeding easterly along the Waitemata County boundary as described in *Gazette*, 1957, page 1295, to the mouth of the Waiwera River; thence southerly along the shores of the Hauraki Gulf and the shores of the Waitemata Harbour to and up the left bank of the Tamaki River to the eastern side of the North Island Main Trunk Railway; thence northerly along the eastern side of that railway, along the south-eastern side of the Auckland-Westfield Loop Line, to and along the middle of the Great South Road, to and westerly generally along the middle of Campbell Road and Mount Albert Road, to and southerly generally along the middle of Dominion Road Extension, to and along the middle of Ridge Road and the middle of Waikowhai Road to the northern shores of the Manukau Harbour; thence south-westerly and northerly generally along the shores of the Manukau Harbour and the Tasman Sea, to and easterly and then northerly along the boundaries of the Kaipara Tribal District hereinbefore described to the point of commencement, together with the islands of Browns, Motuihe, Motutapu, Pine, Rakino, Rangitoto, Waiheke, and other small adjacent islands.

MANUKAU TRIBAL DISTRICT

All that area in the Boroughs of Howick, Papatoetoe, Onehunga, Manurewa, Papakura, parts of the Boroughs of Mount Roskill and One Tree Hill, and the County of Manukau and part of the County of Franklin, bounded by a line commencing at a point on the northern shore of the Manukau Harbour in the middle of the southern end of Waikowhai Road and proceeding northerly along the middle of that road, the middle of Ridge Road, along the middle of Dominion Road Extension, to and easterly along the middle of Mount Albert Road, the middle of Campbell Road, to and southerly along the middle of Great South Road, to and along the south-eastern side of the Auckland-Westfield Loop Line; thence southerly along the eastern side of the North Island Main Trunk Railway to the right bank of an arm of the Tamaki River at the south-western corner of Section 11, Block VI, Otahuhu Survey District; thence easterly generally along the right bank (southern side) of the aforesaid river to and along the shores of the Tamaki Strait and Firth of Thames to the most northerly corner of Tapapakanga Block; thence southerly along the north-western boundary of the aforesaid block to its intersection with the western boundary of Block II, Orere Survey District; thence southerly along the western boundaries of that block and the western boundaries of Block IV, Orere, and Block I, Wharekawa Survey District to its intersection with the northern boundary of the Franklin County as described in *Gazette*, 1956, page 705; thence south-westerly along a right line to the north-eastern corner of Lot 2, D.P. 8057, being part of Allotment 49, Opaheke Parish, situated in Block XII, Drury Survey District; thence north-westerly along a right line to a point in the middle of the Hingaia Creek in line with the southern boundary of Lot 10, D.P. 12364; thence northerly generally up the middle of the aforesaid creek, along the line of mean high-water spring

tide of the Pahurehure Inlet and the Manukau Harbour to the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 43773, being part Allotment 86, Manurewa Parish; situated in Block VIII, Titirangi Survey District; thence by a right line to the middle of the end of Waikowhai Road, the point of commencement, including the island of Wiroa.

HAURAKI TRIBAL DISTRICT

All that area, situated in the South Auckland Land District, bounded by a line commencing at the mouth of the Waikawau River in Block IV, Hastings Survey District; thence proceeding up the middle of the Waikawau River to its source; thence south-easterly along a right line in the direction of the northern head of the Tairua Harbour in Block X, Whitianga Survey District, to its intersection with the production of a right line between Trig. Station 1099 (Maumaupaki) in Block XII, Hastings Survey District, and Trig. Station 23E (Papakai) in Block VIII, Hastings Survey District; thence southerly to and along the last-mentioned right line to Trig. Station 1099 aforesaid, and a right line to Trig. Station 1091 in Block XV, Hastings Survey District; thence easterly along a right line to Trig. Station 97 (Table Mountain); thence southerly along a right line to Trig. Station 89B in Block I, Ohinemuri Survey District, a right line to the north-eastern corner of Hikutaia No. 1B 1A Block and along the eastern boundary of that block and its production to the middle of the Hikutaia River, along a right line to Trig. Station 1862, a right line to the confluence of the Ohinemuri River and the Waitawheta Stream, and a right line to Trig. Station 63 (Karangahake), and along a right line to Trig. Station 567 (Te Aroha); thence south-westerly along a right line to the easternmost point of the Te Aroha Borough as described in *Gazette*, 1917, page 1868; thence along the south-eastern, southern, and western boundaries of that borough to the intersection of the last-mentioned boundary with the middle of the Waihou River; thence down the middle of the Waihou River to its intersection with the southern boundary of the Waihou Survey District; thence westerly along the southern boundary of the Waihou Survey District to the middle of the Piako River, being a point on the boundary of the Hauraki Plains County as described in *Gazette*, 1936, page 842; thence westerly and north-westerly along that county boundary to the southern boundary of Section 1, Block II, Piako Survey District, and along a right line to Trig. Station 135 (Rataroa); thence north-easterly along a right line to the mouth of the Miranda Stream; thence easterly generally along the sea coast to the southernmost corner of Section 1, Block X, Thames Survey District; thence along the western and north-western boundaries of that section to its northernmost point; thence along a right line to the northernmost point of Section 1, Block VII, Thames Survey District; thence along a right line to the intersection of the production of the north-western boundary of Section 3, Block VII, Thames Survey District, with the middle of the Waihou River; thence north-easterly to and along the last-mentioned boundary to its intersection with the southern boundary of the Borough of Thames, as described in the Thames Borough Alteration Act 1918; thence north-westerly generally along the southern, south-western, and northern boundaries of the said borough to the intersection of the last-mentioned boundary with the sea coast; thence northerly along the sea coast to the mouth of the Waikawau River, being the point of commencement.

FRANKLIN TRIBAL DISTRICT

All that area in the County of Franklin and the Boroughs of Pukekohe and Waiuku, bounded by a line commencing at a point on the south head of the Manukau Harbour, being the intersection of the eastern boundary of Titirangi Survey District with the mean high-water spring tide of the aforesaid harbour, and proceeding easterly along that said line of mean high water of the Manukau Harbour and Pahurehure Inlet, to and up the middle of the Hingaia Creek, to and southerly along the boundary of the Manukau Tribal District hereinbefore described to the north-eastern corner of Lot 2, D.P. 8057, situated in Block XII, Drury Survey District; thence along the boundary of the Pou-O-Mangatawhiri Tribal District hereinbefore described to the easternmost corner of Allotment 53, Mangatawhiri Parish in Block IX, Opaheke Survey District; thence south-westerly along a right line to the northern corner of Allotment 12, Pukekohe Parish; thence southerly along another right line to the northern corner of Allotment 106, Tuakau Parish, situated in Block III, Onewhero Survey District; thence southerly along the western boundary of the said Allotment 106, to and westerly along the right bank (north side) of the Waikato River, to and northerly along the sea coast to the south head of the Manukau Harbour, the point of commencement.

POU-O-MANGATAWHIRI TRIBAL DISTRICT

All that area, being part of the Franklin, Waikato, Manukau, and Raglan Counties, bounded by a line commencing at a point at the north-eastern corner of Lot 2, D.P. 8057, being part of Allotment 49, Opaheke Parish, situated in Block XII, Drury Survey District, and proceeding along a right line to the intersection of the northern boundary of Franklin County as described in *Gazette*, 1956, page 705, with the western boundary of Block I, Wharekawa Survey District; thence northerly along the aforesaid western boundary and the western boundary of Orere Survey District to its intersection with the north-western boundary of Tapapakanga Block in Block II, Orere Survey District; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of that block to the Firth of Thames; thence southerly generally

along the sea coast to the mouth of the Miranda Stream; thence along a right line to Trig. Station 135 (Rataroa); thence westerly along another right line through Trig. Station 1417 to the intersection of a right line between Trig. Stations 72 and 98; thence north-easterly along the aforesaid line to Trig. Station 98 in Block VII, Wharekawa Survey District; thence northerly along another right line to the easternmost corner of Allotment 53, Mangatawhiri Parish in Block IX, Opaheke Survey District; thence northerly along a right line to the point of commencement.

RANGIRIRI TRIBAL DISTRICT

All that area in the North Auckland and South Auckland Land Districts, bounded by a line commencing at Trig. Station 72 in Block IV, Awaroa Survey District, and proceeding north-easterly along a right line in the direction of Trig. Station 98 to the south-western corner of Pou-O-Mangatawhiri Tribal District hereinbefore described; thence north-easterly along the southern boundary of the aforesaid tribal district to Trig. Station 135 (Rataroa) in Block VII, Wharekawa Survey District; thence southerly generally along a right line to the north-western corner of Section 38, Block VII, Piako Survey District, along the south-western boundaries of the said Section 38, parts Sections 4 and 5 of the said Block VII, part Section 12, Block XI, and Lot 2 of the said Section 12, along the abutment of a public road, another part of the south-western boundary of the said Section 12, the abutment of another public road and a further part of the south-western boundary of Section 12, and the south-western boundary of Section 5, Block XI, Piako Survey District, and along the western boundary of Section 1, Block XV, Piako Survey District, to Trig. Station 2042 (Ratawera), in the aforesaid Block XV; thence south-westerly along a right line to Trig. Station No. 2043 (Ratamaroke), along another right line to Trig. Station No. 1230 (Pukewhau) in Block V, Hapuakohe Survey District, and along a right line to the confluence of the Mangawhara and the Komakorau Streams in Block VI, Newcastle Survey District; thence northerly generally down the middle of the Mangawhara Stream aforesaid, to and up the middle of the Waikato River to a point in line with a line between the western corner of Section 2, Block XI, Rangiriri Survey District, and the westernmost corner of Section 1, Block IX of the aforesaid Survey District; thence along that right line to the westernmost corner of Section 1 aforesaid, and northerly along another right line to Trig. Station 72, the point of commencement.

PURSUANT to section 6 of the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare the parts of New Zealand described in the Schedule hereto to be a tribal district for the purposes of the said Act with the name therein set out, and do hereby revoke the earlier Proclamation dated 19 April 1947 and published in the *Gazette* of 24 April 1947 at page 482.

SCHEDULE

OTAMATEA TRIBAL DISTRICT

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Wairoa River in line with the north-western boundary of the Parish of Tokatoka; thence proceeding north-easterly along a right line to the westernmost corner of that parish, being a point in the boundary of the Otamatea County as described in the *Gazette* of 1929 at page 1684; thence easterly generally along the generally northern boundary of the said county to the sea coast; thence southerly generally along the sea coast crossing the mouths of all harbours and inlets to the middle of the mouth of the Waiwera River in Block IV, Waiwera Survey District; thence up the middle of that river to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Section 52, Parish of Puhoi; thence to and along the southern and western boundaries of Puhoi Parish to the northern boundary of Makarau Parish; thence north-westerly along a right line passing through

Price Order No. 1818 (Cheese)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following price order:

PRELIMINARY

1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 1818, and shall come into force on the 7th day of October 1960.

2. (1) Price Order No. 1781* is hereby revoked.

(2) The revocation of the said Price Order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this order.

3. (1) In this order, unless the context otherwise requires,—

“The said Act” means the Control of Prices Act 1947:

“The said regulations” mean the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938†:

“Export size”, in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 80 lb. (rinded) or 60 lb. (rindless):

“Medium size”, in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 40 lb.:

“Pancake size”, in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 20 lb.:

“Daisy size”, in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 25 lb.:

“Loaf size”, in relation to any cheese, means a cheese weighing or reputed to weigh approximately 10 lb.:

“Standard lot”, in relation to a transaction for the sale of cheeses, means a lot consisting of two cheeses of export size, or three cheeses of medium size, or six cheeses of pancake size, or five cheeses of daisy size, or nine cheeses of loaf size (rinded), or eight cheeses of loaf size (rindless):

“Manufacturing dairy” means a dairy registered as a cheese factory, pursuant to the said regulations.

(2) Terms and expressions defined in the said Act, or in the said regulations, when used in this order, have the meanings severally assigned thereto by the said Act or by the said regulations as the case may be.

4. For the purposes of this order, any person who sells by retail to any one purchaser, for delivery at any one time, not less than three standard lots of export size, medium size, pancake size, daisy size, or loaf size cheeses, whether or not all the standard lots contain the same size of cheeses, shall in respect of that sale be deemed to be a wholesaler, and the provisions of this order as to maximum wholesale prices shall apply accordingly with respect to every such sale.

APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

5. (1) Except as otherwise provided herein this order applies with respect to all sales in New Zealand by way of wholesale, or retail, of Cheddar cheese that is sold by a wholesaler or retailer, as the case may be, within four months after the date of its manufacture.

(2) For the purposes of this clause the date of the manufacture of any cheese shall be deemed to be the date indicated on the cheese in accordance with the requirements of the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938†.

(3) Every person who sells any Cheddar cheese by retail (whatever the age of such cheese) shall keep, for a period of not less than four months, a record showing the date of the delivery of the cheese to the retailer, and also—

(a) If the whole cheese was sold, without cutting, the date of its sale; or

(b) In any other case, the date on which the cheese was first cut.

(4) In its application to sales by wholesalers, this order applies only to the sale of export size, medium size, pancake size, daisy size, and loaf size cheeses.

(5) In its application to sales by retailers, this order applies to the sale of all Cheddar cheese referred to in subclause (1) of this clause sold by retail.

MAXIMUM PRICES FOR SALES OF CHEESE BY WAY OF WHOLESALE OR BY A MANUFACTURING DAIRY TO A WHOLESALE TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES

6. (1) Subject to the provisions of this order, the maximum price that may be charged or received by any wholesaler for any cheese to which this order applies shall be computed as follows:

Provided that if a wholesaler cuts portions from a whole export or a whole medium cheese for sale by way of wholesale he may add to the appropriate maximum price (computed in accordance with the foregoing table) that may be charged or received for such whole cheese the sum of $\frac{1}{4}$ d. per pound.

Provided further that for the purposes of this order the cutting of a cheese does not alter the classification of such cheese as set out in clause 3 (1) of this order.

(2) For the purposes of this clause the weight of any cheeses, other than those sold in crates and cartons, shall be deemed to be their actual weight when delivered to the purchaser, and the weight of cheeses sold in crates or cartons shall be deemed to be their weight as at the time of placing in crates or cartons.

7. Notwithstanding anything in clause 6 of this order, the maximum prices that may be charged or received for any cheese to which this order applies by any manufacturing dairy upon any sale to a wholesaler shall be $\frac{3}{4}$ d. per pound less than the prices computed in accordance with the said clause.

RETAILERS' PRICES

8. (1) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any cheese to which this order applies shall be determined in accordance with the following provisions, namely:

(a) In the case of cheese sold by a retailer to whom supplies of Cheddar cheese are available, free of freight charges, for delivery at his store from any source whatever, the maximum retail prices shall be: (i) Loaf size 2s. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pound, and (ii) All other sizes 2s. 0 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pound.

(b) In cases to which the last preceding paragraph does not apply, the maximum retail prices shall be:

(i) Loaf size 2s. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pound, and

(ii) All other sizes 2s. 0 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per pound increased to the next upward halfpenny by the appropriate proportion of the freight charges incurred by the retailer in obtaining delivery at his store:

Provided that where any cheese to which this paragraph applies is obtained by the retailer from a source of supply that is not the most convenient of access to the retailer's store, the increase of the price per pound authorised by this paragraph shall not exceed the appropriate proportion of the freight charges that would have been incurred by the retailer if the cheese had been obtained from the source of supply most convenient of access to his store, and if delivery had been effected by a common carrier at current freight rates.

(2) Where the quantity of cheese sold by a retailer in any one transaction is not an exact number of pounds, the maximum price shall be computed at the rate per pound fixed in accordance with the last preceding subclause.

(3) If in respect of any cheese the retail price charged in accordance with the provisions of this clause is not an exact number of pence or halfpence, the maximum price shall be computed to the next upward halfpenny.

FREIGHT CHARGES

9. Any cheese, sold in pursuance of clause 6 of this order by a manufacturing dairy to a wholesaler, shall be delivered freight free to the nearest railway station to the purchaser's premises, or to the point of delivery to which it is customarily given.

SPECIAL PRICES WHERE EXTRAORDINARY CHARGES INCURRED

10. Subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any retailer, may authorise special prices in respect of any cheese to which this order applies where special circumstances exist or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of cheese or may relate generally to all cheese to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force.

- (a) Bookmakers.
- (b) Bookmakers' clerks, bookmakers' assistants, and bookmakers' agents.
- (c) All persons under disqualification imposed under the New Zealand rules of racing or the New Zealand rules of trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside New Zealand which have reciprocal agreements in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or the New Zealand Trotting Conference.
- (d) Common prostitutes, idle and disorderly persons within the meaning of the Police Offences Act 1927.

- (e) Professional tipsters, persons convicted of house breaking, burglary, or pocket picking, forgery, uttering or possessing counterfeit coin, theft, false pretences, receiving stolen goods, mischief, assault, or any offence or crime of any kind under the Crimes Act 1908, and persons convicted under the Police Offences Act 1927 of conversion or attempted conversion of a motorcar or other vehicle or of being idle and disorderly persons or of being a rogue and vagabond and persons convicted of an offence under the Gaming Act 1908, or persons having a criminal record in countries outside New Zealand and the references to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution therefor.

Provided always that the Executive Committee appointed by the New Zealand Racing Conference, upon being satisfied by evidence as to the character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of this regulation should have relief from the effect thereof, may grant exemption to any such person, and may at any time revoke any such exemption without notice to such person, and without assigning any reason for such revocation.
