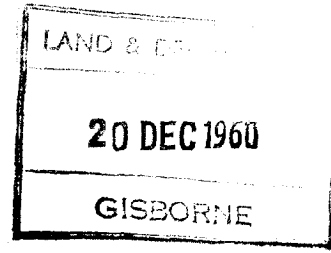

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this order, and subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any retailer, may authorise special maximum prices in respect of any oranges to which this order applies where special circumstances exist, or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of oranges or may relate generally to all oranges to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force.

DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS

6. Every retailer who offers or exposes for sale in any shop any oranges to which this order applies shall keep in a prominent position in such proximity to the oranges to which it relates as to be obviously in relation thereto, a ticket, placard, or label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the word "Californian", and the retail price per pound of the oranges.

8. That the liabilities of the company on the 1st day of October last owing to sundry persons by the company were: On judgment, nil; on speciality, nil; on notes or bills, nil; on simple contracts, £629,342; on estimated liabilities, nil.
9. That the assets of the company on that date were: Government securities, £6,000; other securities, £387,928; bills of exchange and promissory notes, nil; cash on deposit and at bank, £304,292.
