

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that an easement is hereby taken over the land described in the First Schedule hereto for waterworks purposes vesting in perpetuity in the body corporate called the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Auckland full, free and uninterrupted right, liberty, authority, and license from time to time and at all times hereafter to convey water under, along, and over the said land, and for such purpose to lay, construct, relay, reconstruct, cleanse, repair, and maintain a water pipeline and main or any number of water pipelines and mains of such size and type as the Corporation shall think fit through the said land, and to convey water in unimpeded flow through such pipes and mains and for such purposes by its engineers, surveyors, servants, agents, employees, workmen, and contractors to enter upon and to pass and repass over the said land with or without horses or vehicles, laden or unladen, and materials, machinery, and implements, to make on the said land any cuttings, fillings, grades, batters,

or trenches, and to reopen any such trenches and to lay, construct, place, remove, relay, reconstruct, cleanse, repair, and maintain any water pipes and mains or lay, lift, repair, and relay any substitutional or additional pipes and mains and to do all and singular upon, through, under, or across the said land such acts, deeds, matters, and things as the Corporation, its engineers, surveyors, servants, agents, employees, workmen, or contractors may consider necessary or desirable for or in any wise in connection with the laying, constructing, placing, inspecting, removing, relaying, reconstructing, cleansing, repairing, and maintaining or using such water pipes and mains and the transmission of water through, under, and across the said land upon the terms and conditions set out in the Second Schedule hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 6th day of February 1961.

- (c) Potatoes (other than those covered by (a) or (b) above) which are sold by the grower as seed and delivered direct to another grower for use for seed purposes.
- (d) Potatoes sold by the grower for shipment to the Pacific Islands and known as "Island Smalls", provided that the maximum size of such potatoes does not exceed 4.5 oz.

3. Potatoes which are sold by the grower without pre-sale grading as to size and which are not exempt from the levy in accordance with any subsection of section 2 shall be subject as to 70 per cent of the quantity sold to the full levy notwithstanding any subsequent grading thereof by the purchaser.

4. For the purposes of section 3 of this resolution, "grower" shall not include any person, firm, or company which has contracted in any manner whatsoever with the occupier of any land for the acquisition of any potatoes grown thereon.

- (e) Professional tipsters, persons convicted of house breaking, burglary, or pocket picking, forgery, uttering or possessing counterfeit coin, theft, false pretences, receiving stolen goods, mischief, assault, or any offence or crime of any kind under the Crimes Act 1908, and persons convicted under the Police Offences Act 1927 of conversion or attempted conversion of a motorcar or other vehicle or of being idle and disorderly persons or of being a rogue and vagabond and persons convicted of an offence under the Gaming Act 1908, or persons having a criminal record in countries outside New Zealand and the references to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution therefor.

Provided always that the Executive Committee appointed by the New Zealand Racing Conference, upon being satisfied by evidence as to the character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of this regulation should have relief from the effect thereof, may grant exemption to any such person, and may at any time revoke any such exemption without notice to such person, and without assigning any reason for such revocation.

WAIPA RACING CLUB (INC.) RESOLUTION

At the annual general meeting of the Waipa Racing Club (Inc.) held on the 24th day of September 1958 at Te Awamutu, it was duly resolved as follows:

"In pursuance and exercise of the powers under section 33 of the Gaming Act 1908 it is hereby resolved that the regulations dated the 28th day of September 1948 are hereby revoked, and in lieu thereof the following regulations shall be regulations under the said section 33 controlling the admission of persons to that part of the Waipa County situated in the district of Waikato and known as the Te Awamutu Racecourse or to any other racecourse used or occupied by the club for race meetings."

WAIPA RACING CLUB (INC.) REGULATIONS  
(Under the Gaming Act 1908)

1. These regulations shall come into force on the date of the same being published in the *Gazette*.

2. In these regulations the words "bookmaker," "racing club," and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by section 2 of the Gaming Act 1908.

3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from the racecourse above described or any other racecourse while the same is used or occupied by the said club for a race meeting, namely:

- (a) Bookmakers.
- (b) Bookmakers' clerks, bookmakers' assistants, and bookmakers' agents.
- (c) All persons under disqualification imposed under the New Zealand rules of racing or the New Zealand rules of trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside New Zealand which have reciprocal agreements in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or the New Zealand Trotting Conference.
- (d) Common prostitutes, idle and disorderly persons within the meaning of the Police Offences Act 1927.

(e) Professional tipsters, persons convicted of house breaking, burglary, or pocket picking, forgery, uttering or possessing counterfeit coin, theft, false pretences, receiving stolen goods, mischief, assault, or any offence or crime of any kind under the Crimes Act 1908, and persons convicted under the Police Offences Act 1927 of conversion or attempted conversion of a motorcar or other vehicle or of being idle and disorderly persons or of being a rogue and vagabond and persons convicted of an offence under the Gaming Act 1908, or persons having a criminal record in countries outside New Zealand and the references to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution therefor.

Provided always that the Executive Committee appointed by the New Zealand Racing Conference, upon being satisfied by evidence as to the character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of this regulation should have relief from the effect thereof, may grant exemption to any such person, and may at any time revoke any such exemption without notice to such person, and without assigning any reason for such revocation.
