For the purpose of this order, and notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the said Act, any person who sells by retail to any one purchaser for delivery at any one time not less than two standard case lots of honey shall, in respect of the sale, be deemed to be a wholesaler, and the provisions of this order as to maximum wholesale prices shall apply accordingly with respect to the sale. ingly with respect to every such sale.
- 5. The maximum prices fixed by this order apply with respect to sales by auction as well as to other sales.
