4. For all elections under this order the Returning Officer shall be the Secretary of the Board for the time being.

5. The electors of the city members shall be the members

6. Every city member shall be elected by resolution passed at a meeting of the Dunedin City Council.

7. Unless an extraordinary vacancy otherwise requires, the next election of city members shall be held on some day in the month of November 1965 between the 15th day and the 30th day of that month, and subsequent elections shall be held on some day in the same period in the same month of every third year thereafter.

8. In the case of an extraordinary vacancy in the office of a city member, the Returning Officer shall give notice in writing thereof to the Dunedin City Council, and an election to fill the office so vacated shall be held not later than one month after the date when such notice is given.

9. It shall be the duty of the Mayor of the City of Dunedin to cause a meeting of the Dunedin City Council to be held for the purpose of conducting an election under this order whenever necessary.

10. It shall be the duty of the Town Clerk of the Dunedin City Council immediately following an election by the Dunedin City Council under this order to give notice of the result thereof in writing to the Returning Officer, who shall notify the Minister of Internal Affairs accordingly.

Unless an extraordinary vacancy otherwise requires, the next election of the local authority member shall take place by means of meetings to be held on some day in the month of November 1965 between the 15th day and the 30th day of that month and subsequent elections shall be held on some day in the same period in the same month of every third year

16. The Returning Officer shall thereupon prepare a list of nominated candidates and send a copy thereof to each of the local authorities, which shall, at a meeting held on some day

No failure on the part of any local authority to hold any meeting as hereby prescribed, or to carry at such a meeting a resolution allocating its votes, or to lodge a sealed copy of such resolution with the Returning Officer within the time hereby prescribed, or otherwise to exercise its power of voting shall affect the validity of any election.

as relate to the hours of commencing or ceasing work, or to the issue of permits, or to the payment for overtime, or ex-tended hours, or to holidays, and half-holidays, or to the closing of shops.

1. Forty hours shall constitute a week's work, to be worked on five days of the week, and eight hours shall constitute a day's work in or about the exhibition, and, with the exception set out in clause 2 hereof, the daily hours shall be worked

2. No person shall be employed in or about the exhibition for more than four hours without an interval of at least three-quarters of an hour for a meal.

3. two hours and at not less than twice the ordinary rate thereafter.

(b) Any person employed in or about the exhibition on any day that would, but for the provisions of this order, have been a whole holiday for that person by virtue of any Act or of any award or industrial agreement shall be paid for all work done on that day at not less than twice the ordinary rate, whether the work is performed wholly in or about the exhibition or otherwise: Provided that nothing in this subclause shall be deemed to deprive any person of any other payment for the said holiday to which he is entitled under any Act or award or industrial agreement.

4. No male under 18 years of age and no female shall be employed in or about the exhibition after the hour of 10.30 p.m.

5. For the purposes of the enforcement of an award or industrial agreement, any provision of which has been suspended by this order, any officer of the industrial union or association concerned who is authorised in writing in that behalf by the union or association shall be entitled to interview at his place of employment any person employed in or about the exhibition under that award or industrial agreement at such time or times as may be agreed upon between the officer and the employer of that person, and for this purpose any such officer shall be entitled at any time to have access to the register of passes issued by the promoter.
