IN exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 23 of the Counties Act 1956, and amendments thereto, the Ellesmere County Council resolves by way of Special Order as follows:

1. The present division of the County of Ellesmere into eight ridings is revoked and in lieu thereof the said county shall be divided into seven ridings to be called Greenpark Riding, Springston Riding, Irwell Riding, Southbridge Riding, Rakaia Riding, Southbridge Town Riding, and Leeston Town Riding, which said ridings are respectively described in the Schedule hereto.

2. The said Ellesmere County Council shall consist of 13 members, who shall be elected as follows:

- The electors of the Greenpark Riding, Springston Riding, Southbridge Riding, and Rakaia Riding shall each elect two councillors.
- The electors of the Irwell Riding shall elect three councillors.
- The electors of the Leeston Town Riding and the Southbridge Town Riding shall each elect one councillor.

3. The alteration hereby made shall take effect on and after the 1st day of April 1965.

SCHEDULE

ALTERING and defining the boundaries of the Southbridge, Irwell, Springston, Greenpark, and Rakaia Ridings of the County of Ellesmere.

SOUTHBRIDGE RIDING

IRWELL RIDING

ALL that area in the County of Ellesmere, Canterbury Land District, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Selwyn River in line with the middle of Selwyn Road, Block V, Leeston Survey District, and proceeding south-westerly along the middle lines of Selwyn Road and Rakaia and Selwyn Road to the middle of Tramway Road; thence south-easterly and easterly generally along the middle lines of that road, Cowans Road, Southbridge Sedgemere Road, and Ridge Road to the middle of Lower Lake Road; thence northerly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the southern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 13935; thence to and along that boundary and its production to the western shore of Lake Ellesmere; thence southerly generally along that shore to the northern boundary of Section 22, Maori Reserve 878; thence easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of that section to the sea coast; thence north-easterly along the sea coast to the original outlet of Lake Ellesmere; thence north-easterly along a right line to the middle of the mouth of the Halswell River on the north-eastern shore of Lake Ellesmere; thence north-westerly generally along the general north-eastern shore of that lake to the middle of the mouth of the Selwyn River; thence north-westerly generally along the middle of that river to the point of commencement, excluding therefrom the Leeston Town Riding as described in *N.Z. Gazette*, 1960, page 143.

SPRINGSTON RIDING

ALL that area in the County of Ellesmere, Canterbury Land District, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Selwyn River in line with the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 10260, Block XII, Leeston Survey District, and proceeding north-westerly generally along the middle of that river to the middle of the South Island Main Trunk Railway; thence north-easterly along the middle of that railway to a point in line with the middle line of the Main South Road fronting Rural Sections 4877, 4627, and 4434, Block XV, Rolleston Survey District; thence north-easterly to and along that middle line, south-easterly generally to and along the middle lines of Weedons Road and Boundary Road, southerly to and along the middle line of Springs Road, westerly to and along the middle line of Collins Road, southerly generally to and along the middle lines of Tramway Road and Curries Road to the middle line of Pannetts Road; thence westerly along that middle line to a point in line with the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 10260; thence southerly to and along that boundary and its production to the point of commencement.

GREENPARK RIDING

ALL that area in the County of Ellesmere, Canterbury Land District, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the mouth of the Selwyn River on the northern shore of Lake Ellesmere, Block XVI, Leeston Survey District, and proceeding north-westerly along the middle of the Selwyn River to a point in line with the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 10260; thence northerly to and along that boundary and its production to the middle line of Pannetts Road; thence easterly along that middle line, northerly generally to and along the middle lines of Curries Road and Tramway Road, easterly to and along the middle line of Collins Road, northerly to and along the middle line of Springs Road to the middle line of Boundary Road; thence south-easterly along the middle line of the last-mentioned road and its production to the middle line of Prebbleton-Lincoln Road; thence south-westerly along the middle lines of that road and James Street, south-easterly generally to and along the middle lines of Edward Street and Lincoln Tai Tapu Road and the production of the last-mentioned middle line to the middle of the Halswell River; thence south-easterly generally along the middle of that river to its mouth on the northern shore of Lake Ellesmere; thence north-westerly generally along the general north-eastern shore of that lake to the point of commencement.

RAKAIA RIDING

ALL that area in the County of Ellesmere, Canterbury Land District, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Rakaia River in line with the middle of Steels Road, Block II, Hall Survey District, proceeding north-easterly generally to and along the middle of that road to the middle of Rakaia Terrace Road; thence south-easterly along the middle of that road to West Boundary road; thence north-easterly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Reserve 1765; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary and its production to the middle of Ardlui Road; thence northerly and north-easterly along the middle lines of that road and a road forming the north-western boundary of Rural Section 37002 and passing through part Reserve 1834 to the middle of Hororata-Dunsandel Road; thence south-easterly along the middle of that road to the middle of a road passing through Reserves 3373 and 1763 and forming the south-eastern boundaries of Lots 5 and 6, D.P. 3012, and Rural Section 10806; thence north-easterly along the middle of that road and its production to the middle of the Selwyn River; thence south-easterly down the middle of that river to the middle of Selwyn Road, Block V, Leeston Survey District; thence south-westerly along the middle lines of that road, Rakaia and Selwyn Road, and Old South Road to the middle of the Rakaia River; thence north-westerly up the middle of that river to the point of commencement.

LEESTON TOWN RIDING

ALL that area in the County of Ellesmere, Canterbury Land District, as described in *N.Z. Gazette*, 1960, page 143.

SOUTHBRIDGE TOWN RIDING

ALL that area in the County of Ellesmere, Canterbury Land District, as described in *N.Z. Gazette*, 1960, page 144.

The Indecent Publications Act 1963

IN the matter of the Indecent Publications Act 1963 and in the matter of an application by E. J. Hyams and Son Ltd., on behalf of The New English Library Ltd., of London, in respect of a book *The Carpetbaggers* by Harold Robbins (in a paperback edition).

DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL

THE tribunal has considered the application of the firm of E. J. Hyams and Son Ltd. on behalf of the publishers—made with the consent of the Minister of Justice—for a decision in respect of the above-named book—whether it is indecent or not, or alternatively a decision as to its classification.

Brief submissions were offered by counsel for the applicant in support of the application. Counsel for the Secretary for Justice made no submissions.

The book is a paperback edition. It is a long story prolix to the point of tediousness. There are accounts of sexual behaviour but we do not consider the narrative is such as to deprave a reader or to be injurious to the public good. We do not think there is any warrant for holding it to be indecent.

We determine accordingly that the book is not indecent within the meaning of the Statute.

The Indecent Publications Act 1963

IN the matter of the Indecent Publications Act 1963 and in the matter of an application by Hicks, Smith and Son Ltd., as agents for Penguin Books Ltd., of Harmondsworth, Middlesex, England, in respect of a paperback edition of *Lady Chatterley's Lover* by D. H. Lawrence.

DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL

THE tribunal has considered an application made on behalf of Penguin Books Ltd.—with the consent of the Minister of Justice—for a decision in respect of a paperback edition of *Lady Chatterley's Lover*—whether it is indecent or not, or for a decision as to its classification.

Two applications to the Minister were made regarding this book—one in respect of a hard-back edition published by William Heineman Ltd., which has a preface by the author, the retail price of which in New Zealand is 16s. and the other in respect of a paperback edition published by Penguin Books Ltd. which has an introduction by Richard Hoggart and which it is intended to retail in New Zealand at 5s. The application for submission of the hard-back edition to the tribunal was refused by the Minister who however consented to the paperback edition being so submitted, which accordingly has been done. The hard-back edition has been put into general circulation in New Zealand and indeed is prominently displayed in many book shops.

Our function is to consider and to classify the paperback edition, but it is in our opinion a relevant consideration that the hard-back edition is on unrestricted sale in New Zealand. The text of the story is in the case of each identical; there is no difference between the two editions save in regard to the preface of the one and the introduction of the other and the form of each respectively.

We had lengthy submissions from counsel for the applicant and for the Secretary for Justice respectively. The general tenor of those made by counsel for the applicant were that the book was a serious well written story and though it contained sexual episodes described very realistically there was no glorification of sex, no undue or harmful emphasis on sex, and that the book was not one which would tend to deprave a reader. It was said that the paperback edition was a completion in that form of all Lawrence's works; and that it had been on sale in the United Kingdom for from four to five years. Counsel for the Secretary for Justice submitted that having regard to the contents of the book it should be held to be indecent, or at least indecent in the hands of persons under 18 years of age.

The submissions of counsel were well presented and not lacking in cogency. Both invoked the provisions of the Statute and we have given a good deal of thought to the matter.

That the book is a seriously written work by an author who has an established place in the field of English literature is not challenged. This particular book is well known; it has been much discussed; and it has been the subject of judicial consideration in England, Canada, and elsewhere. There has been a considerable conflict of judicial opinion as to whether it is indecent or obscene; but in each case the question had to be determined under the particular Statute there in force. Such decisions as there have been in other jurisdictions have therefore only a limited application to New Zealand since the Indecent Publications Act of 1963 is a considerable advance on any legislation in this field hitherto enacted here or elsewhere. In particular the New Zealand Statute contemplates five types of classification in respect of a publication, namely, whether it is indecent or not indecent, or whether it is indecent in the hands of persons under a specified age, or indecent unless circulation is restricted to specified persons or classes of persons, or whether used for a particular purpose.

It is beyond question that the book contains accounts of several acts of sexual behaviour described in language which is exceedingly frank and to some readers must be repellent. Nevertheless these very realistic descriptions of the relations between Lady Chatterley and her lover are not in our opinion, an undue exploitation of sex. Though the story is in the main concerned with the sexual relations of Lady Chatterley and her lover—the gamekeeper Mellors—there is no perversion depicted, merely that the union of these two persons was the fulfilment of natural instincts and urges. It is a trite observation that the task of the tribunal must be to consider the book as a whole—not whether particular words or passages are indecent. The tribunal has previously held, and holds, that indecency is not to be found in words as such, but in their use in indecent contexts or for discreditable purposes. The novel is a complex piece of writing which is not without literary merit. It certainly displays sufficient skill on the author's part to justify its being regarded as a work of art. Its main theme is the development of the relationship between Lady Chatterley and her lover Mellors in pursuance of the author's doctrine of sex and love. It deals as well with the effect of industrialisation and class barriers in England against which Lawrence opposes his ideal conception of love.

In other jurisdictions where the book has been considered judicially there has been a great difference of opinion as to whether the book is an undue exploitation of sex or whether it offends against community standards. The dominant consideration under the New Zealand Statute is whether the book deals with matters of sex (*inter alia*) in a manner which is "injurious to the public good". We have accordingly addressed ourselves in particular to this aspect.

Our conclusion is that though the author has described in great detail sexual behaviour in language which would be offensive to many nevertheless the passages are but an integral part of his general theme. The author has been held by persons having literary qualifications to be entitled to be regarded as an outstanding contributor to English literature and we do not think any significant number of persons would be deprived or corrupted by reading this book.

There is however a more difficult question. Under the Statute we are required to consider—as counsel for the Secretary for Justice urged—whether the book is indecent in the hands of persons under—*it was suggested*—18 years of age, and that since it would be difficult to ensure such a restriction being effective there should be a general ban on the paperback edition having regard to its form and proposed price of 5s. We have no hesitation in holding the book unsuitable for juveniles, not so much because of the language in which the sexual episodes are described as because, in our opinion, mentally immature minors would be incapable of appreciating the theme of the story and the purpose of the writer. As to how the book should be classified there is a difference of opinion among the members of the tribunal. Three members—the Chairman, Mr Schroder, and Mr Perry—think that on a realistic view and having regard to the circumstances existing, namely, the unrestricted circulation of the hard-back edition, it would be futile to classify the paperback edition as indecent in the hands of juveniles; that it might indeed operate as an incentive to minors to procure and read the book; that though by implication the tribunal's finding that the book is unsuitable reading for young persons must apply equally to the hard-back edition nevertheless that edition is being freely circulated, prominently displayed in book shops and is available to persons of all ages. But two members of the tribunal—Professor Gordon and Mrs Cochran—hold otherwise. They dissent upon the basis that the function of the tribunal is to provide

for adults as much freedom as possible both to read and to write, and to give protection where necessary to those who are still of immature years; that the tribunal is agreed that *Lady Chatterley's Lover* is unsuitable reading for juveniles; that the Statute provides for the classification of books to restrict sales to certain age groups, a provision which removes the necessity of banning completely a book which happens to be unsuitable for any given class of readers and allows the tribunal to respect the rights of adults as well as the best interests of school children. Their view is that the right granted by the Statute should be invoked, and that even with the diminished effect such action would now have, the sale of the Penguin edition should be restricted to persons of 17 years and over. They would have adopted the same classification in respect of the hard-back edition had that book been submitted. They think it is a matter for regret that the free circulation of the hard-cover edition should have prejudiced the issue, embarrassed the tribunal, and made it virtually impossible in a particularly clear instance to invoke the provisions of the Statute. The finding of the majority that because the Minister of Justice refused to allow the hard-back edition to be submitted to the tribunal it would therefore be futile to impose a restriction on the Penguin edition they regard as a policy of expediency rather than principle.

The majority view must of course govern the decision which is that the tribunal holds that the paper-back edition of *Lady Chatterley's Lover* published by Penguin Books is not indecent within the meaning of the Indecent Publications Act 1963.
