SYSTEM OF SUPPLY

3. The system of supply shall be as described in paragraph (d) of regulation 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 and shall be an alternating current system.

DURATION OF LICENCE

4. Unless sooner lawfully determined this licence shall con-tinue in force until the 31st day of March 1986 or until a supply of electricity is available from an electric power board or other public source of supply, whichever is the earlier.
