PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 19 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting on the joint recommendation of the Minister of Lands and of the Minister of Forests, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being provisional State forest reserve set apart by Proclamation dated the 7th day of October 1930, and published in *Gazette*, 9 October 1930, Volume III, page 3122; by Proclamation dated the 1st day of December 1936, and published in *Gazette*, 3 December 1936, Volume III, page 2324; by Proclamation dated the 18th day of December 1952, and published in *Gazette*, 15 January 1953, Volume I, page 2, is required for settlement purposes; and in accordance with the provisions of the said Act such land shall, from and after the day of gazetting hereof, cease to be provisional State forest land and shall become Crown land available for sale, lease, reservation, or other disposition under the provisions of the Land Act 1948.

Amending a Proclamation Setting Apart and Defining Boundaries of Provisional State Forests

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 7th day of October 1930, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, on the 9th day of that month, at page 3122 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation"), the boundaries of certain provisional State forests in Karamea and Westland Mining Districts were defined, and certain other lands in the said mining districts were set apart as provisional State forests under the Forests Act 1921-22:

And whereas certain errors were made in the Schedule to the said Proclamation by describing part Provisional State Forest No. 1576; part Provisional State Forest No. 1594; part Provisional State Forest No. 1714; two parts Provisional State Forest No. 1715; and Provisional State Forest No. 1740, Westland Land District, as Crown land:

And whereas by a further Proclamation dated the 24th day of March 1931, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, on the 26th day of that month, at page 701, (hereinafter referred to as "the amending Proclamation"), the aforesaid errors were purported to have been rectified by substituting the revised descriptions included in the Schedule of the amending Proclamation for the descriptions of the provisional State forests hereinbefore referred to and included in the Schedule to the said Proclamation:

And whereas it has subsequently appeared that a certain error was made in the Schedule to the amending Proclamation by describing as part Provisional State Forest No. 1715, Westland Land District, 107 acres, more or less, of Crown land:

And whereas it is desirable such last mentioned error be rectified:

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 21 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Brigadier Sir Bernard Edward Fergusson, the Governor-General of New Zealand, do hereby amend the said Proclamation as amended by the amending Proclamation, by substituting the Schedule hereto for the Schedule to the amending Proclamation, and do declare that this Proclamation shall take effect as from the 7th day of October 1930.

Timber Preservation Regulations 1955—Branding and Identification of Preservative Treated Timber

PURSUANT to regulation 12 of the Timber Preservation Regulations 1955*, notice is hereby given that, subject to the exemptions provided herein, timber which has been preservative treated as provided in the said regulations shall be branded or identified in the manner herein described.

1. All preservative treated timber shall be branded on or at one end with a clearly legible brand in block letters not less than $\frac{1}{8}$ in. high. The brand shall include the registered number of the plant allocated by the Timber Preservation Authority. Timbers exempt from this requirement are:

- Fence battens and droppers.
- Timber in sizes 2 in. by 1 in. section and less.
- Timber to be dressed or planer-gauged and branded in accordance with clause 4 (a), (b), or (c) at or adjacent to the treatment plant at which it is treated.

2. In the case of timber treated for ground contact use to comply with T.P.A. specification I and II (Group A timbers only) and specification III, an additional brand in the form of an "X" is to be placed immediately after the plant number.

3. Each piece of timber treated with a preservative which does not colour the timber shall have its surfaces coloured by a colouring material, approved by the Authority, added to the treating solution.

4. (a) All weatherboards and flooring shall be continuously branded on the back of the board.

(b) All scantlings and timber which are dressed or planer-gauged on at least one surface shall be continuously branded on at least one face.

(c) All other finishing lines shall be either continuously surface branded or surface branded within 6 in. of the end.

(d) All posts, poles, and piles shall be branded with an incised brand on one end or with a disc approved by the Authority and fixed above groundline.

(e) All surface branding shall be incised or branded with a permanent ink approved by the Authority and shall be in block letters not less than $\frac{3}{8}$ in. high embodying the word "treated", together with, as a minimum, the number or trade

name approved by the Authority for the organisation performing this branding and may include the type of treatment as a prefix and other information.

(f) Continuous brands must repeat at not more than 24 in. centres.

5. Notwithstanding anything in the provisions of this Notice the Authority may, if it thinks fit, in special circumstances, grant dispensation from any of the foregoing provisions.

6. The provisions of this Notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

7. The previous notice published in the *Gazette*, 28 June 1962, is hereby revoked.

- (a) The lease shall commence on the date of settlement and shall continue until the Society is able to give vacant possession of the Panama buildings to the Council.

- (c) The Council shall be responsible for the repair and maintenance of the buildings and for insuring the buildings to their full insurable value.
- (d) The Society shall maintain and care for the persons resident in Panama on the date of settlement until such persons are suitably accommodated elsewhere and shall provide such staff and other services as shall be necessary from time to time to accomplish that purpose.
