Ltd. has agreed to sell phosphatic fertilizer to the Hawke's Bay Trading Society Ltd., the Economic Trading Association (Wairarapa) Ltd., and the Gisborne, East Coast Trading Society Ltd.

WHEREAS the Trade Practices and Prices Commission has received from the Examiner of Trade Practices and Prices (hereinafter referred to as "the Examiner") a report, pursuant to section 17 of the said Act, in which it was alleged that the East Coast Farmers' Fertilizer Co. Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "the company") refused to accept orders from the Hawke's Bay Trading Society Ltd., the Economic Trading Association (Wairarapa) Ltd., and the Gisborne, East Coast Trading Society Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "the societies") under the terms applicable to incorporated farmers' organisations, as defined in clause 4 (1) (e) of the price order relating to phosphatic fertilizers (hereinafter referred to as "the price order");

And whereas the said Examiner's report alleged that this

And whereas the said Examiner's report alleged that this refusal was a trade practice, in terms of section 19 (2) (i) of the said Act, which was contrary to the public interest in terms of section 20 (1) (a) and (d) of the said Act;

And whereas in the said report of the Examiner he stated that he had conducted conciliation proceedings with the company under the provisions of section 16A of the said Act, and that the company, while denying the Examiner's allegations that its action was a trade practice which was contrary to the public interest, nevertheless had agreed to accept orders from the societies under the terms specified in the said price order on specific terms to obviate the risk of financial loss to the company in trading with the societies, and that the said societies had agreed to the specific terms as to payment for the supplies; ment for the supplies;

And whereas the Examiner has recommended that the Commission should make an order under section 19 of the said Act to direct the company to discontinue the practice of refusing to accept orders from the societies, provided the

said societies conform to the procedure agreed upon by the company and the societies relating to the payment by the societies prior to delivery of the fertilizer by the company.

And whereas the Commission is satisfied that all persons who would be bound by any order made by the Commission pursuant to the recommendation by the said Examiner in the said report have concurred with the recommendation made by the said Examiner in the said report and the Commission has dispensed with an inquiry under section 18 of the said Act;

And whereas the Commission decided that an order should be made under the said Act to give effect to the said recommendation;

Now, therefore, the Trade Practices and Prices Commission hereby orders and directs

the East Coast Farmers' Fertilizer Company Ltd., to accept orders for phosphatic fertilizer from the Hawke's Bay Trading Society Ltd., the Economic Trading Association (Wairarapa) Ltd., and the Gisborne, East Coast Trading Society Ltd., provided that the said societies conform with the conditions for payment of supplies as set out hereunder, or on such other terms as may be agreed upon from time to time between the company and any of the said societies.

TERMS FOR PAYMENT

In this order the word "price" means:

(a) In the case of phosphatic fertilizer, subject to the provisions of a price order, the price stated in the

(b) In the case of fertilizers which are subject to the approval of the Department of Industries and Commerce, under authority delegated by the Price Tribunal, the price so approved by the Department in accordance with the formula approved by the Price Tribunal and duly notified to the Department as directed by the Price Tribunal.

Decision of the Indecent Publications Tribunal

In the matter of the Indecent Publications Act 1963 and the matter of an application by Transworld Publishing Ho of Barsley Lane, London, in respect of numbers 3, 4, 5 of a magazine called Penthouse.

DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL

THE TRIBUNAL sat to consider the above application, must the consent of the Minister of Justice, relating numbers 3, 4, and 5. The applicant had previously obtathe leave of the Minister in respect of numbers 3, 4, 5, 6. There are some seriously-written articles deal with abortion, promiscuity, and Casanova, but in orespects the publication does not in our opinion display honest purpose but seeks rather to emphasise and exploit.

We think the circulation of the numbers we have nounced upon to be contrary to the public interest. Accingly, we hold issues 3, 4, and 5 to be indecent in the hof persons under 18 years of age. We hesitate to bar acfrom reading them, but on an overall consideration we these issues should be held to be indecent within the mean of the statute and we so decide.

Mr Schroder, who was not present at the hearing of application, does not participate in this decision. One men of the Tribunal—Mr Perry—holds the view that taking issue as a whole, and in spite of features which m properly be considered offensive or in poor taste, ther enough of value in each of the three issues to rende complete ban inappropriate; in his view these issues should be withheld from persons 18 years or over who wishese them see them.

The balances to be maintained as aforesaid shall be exclusive of any balance held by a trading bank in its wool retention or special fund account at the Reserve Bank.
