A PROCLAMATION

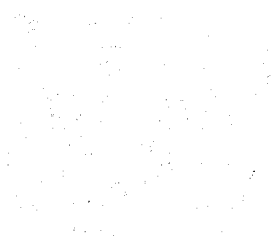
