ALTERATIONS TO SCALE OF CHARGES Alteration to the Scale of Charges Upon the New Zealand Government Railways

GENERAL SCALE OF CHARGES

Pursuant to the Government Railways Act 1949, the Minister of Railways hereby makes the following alterations to the General Scale of Charges made on the 5th day of March 1965 and published in the Supplement dated the 12th day of May 1965 to the New Zealand Gazette of the 6th day of May 1965, and to the charges, terms, and conditions contained in sections 68 to 71 inclusive published in the Supplement to the New Zealand Gazette dated 2 September 1963, and to the Local Rates Scale of Charges made on the 27th day of April 1965 and published in the Supplement dated the 24th day of May 1965 to the New Zealand Gazette of the 20th day of May 1965 in force on the New Zealand Government Railways, and hereby declares that such alterations shall come into force on the days set out hereunder:

GENERAL SCALE OF CHARGES
