as relate to the hours of commencing or ceasing work, or to the issue of permits, or to the payment for overtime, or extended hours, or to holidays, and half holidays, or to the closing of shops.

Amendments to Rules of the Hawke's Bay Acclimatisation Society

PURSUANT to section 29 of the Wildlife Act 1953, the Minister of Internal Affairs hereby gives notice that he has approved rule 8 of the Society's rules being revoked and the following rule 8 enacted in substitution therefore.

COUNCIL

8. (1) The Society shall be governed by a Council of 16 members, who shall, so long as they continue to be members of the Society, hold office for two years, and a President. Those members and the President shall be elected from and by the general membership in accordance with subclause (2) of this rule and shall not be eligible for election unless they have their permanent and principal or only place of residence within the district.

(2) (a) Four members of the Council shall be elected from such members who have their permanent and principal or only place of residence in that part of the district north of a line commencing at the mouth of the Tutaekuri River and thence up the centre of the river to that point on the western boundary of the district adjacent to its source.

(b) Four members of the Council shall be elected from such members who have their permanent and principal or only place of residence in the balance of the County of Hawke's Bay.

(c) Four members of the Council shall be elected from such members who have their permanent and principal or only place of residence in that part of the district which is bounded in the north by the southern boundary of the County of Hawke's Bay and in the south by a line extending from the centre of Tungara Cove on a bearing of 270 degrees to the western boundary of the district.

(d) Four members of the Council shall be elected from such members who have their permanent and principal or only place of residence in the remaining part of the district.

(3) The President shall, so long as he continues to be a member of the Society, hold office for two years. He shall be eligible for re-election by ballot of the general membership. If for any reason the position of President becomes vacant, the Council may elect one of its members to be President for the unexpired term.

(4) The Council at its first meeting following the annual general meeting shall elect such number of Vice-Presidents as it sees fit. The Vice-Presidents shall retire as Vice-Presidents at the next annual general meeting held after their election, but shall be eligible for re-election.

(5) At each annual general meeting the eight Councillors who have been longest on the Council without being re-elected shall retire but shall be eligible for re-election, but in the case of unequal numbers of representatives from any area, half adjusted to the next whole figure shall retire in one year, and the balance in the year following. The vacancies created under this rule shall be filled by ballot as provided in rule 9 hereof.

(6) Vacancies on the Council caused by the retirement of members shall be filled from such members as will maintain the proportional or district representation as set out in subclause (2) of this rule.

(7) Where any member of the Council ceases to have his permanent and principal or only place of residence within the district he shall cease to be a member of the Council as from the commencement of the next annual general meeting.

(8) In the event of any member of the Council dying, resigning, or vacating his office, the Council may appoint to the vacancy any member of the Society who is available and eligible. Such appointee shall hold office for the balance of the term of his predecessor. Any such appointment shall maintain the proportional or district representation as set out in subclause (2) of this rule.

(9) A member of this Council shall vacate his office if he has absented himself from three consecutive meetings of the Council without leave of absence having been granted by the Council.

(10) An elected member or a member appointed to fill a vacancy under subclause (8) of this rule shall vacate his office if he ceases to be a member of the Society.

Order No. 1 (1967) of the Trade Practices and Prices Commission

IN the matter of the Trade Practices Act 1958 and in the matter of a common pricing arrangement among manufacturers of earthenware pipes sold in the Christchurch area:

WHEREAS the Trade Practices and Prices Commission has received from the Examiner of Trade Practices and Prices (hereinafter referred to as "the Examiner") a report, pursuant to section 17 of the said Act, alleging the existence of a common pricing arrangement operated in the name of the Earthenware Drain Pipe Co. by all three manufacturers of earthenware drain pipes and fittings in the Christchurch area, namely Austin Chalk Co. Ltd., McSkimming Industries Ltd., and Murphy Bros. (Christchurch) Ltd.;

And whereas the examiner in his report alleged that the pricing arrangement operated by the said manufacturers was a trade practice in terms of section 19 (2) (b) of the said Act, and was contrary to the public interest in terms of section 20 (1) (d) of the said Act;

And whereas in the said report the Examiner has stated that section 16A of the said Act has been complied with, and that the said manufacturers have consented to the nature of his recommendation to the Trade Practices and Prices Commission in respect of the said trade practice, and have consented to the making of an order of the nature recommended by him;

And whereas the Commission is satisfied that all persons who would be bound by any order made by the Commission

And whereas the Commission decided that an order of the nature recommended by the Examiner in the said report should be made under the said Act:

- (a) To discontinue the practice of consulting together, either directly or through an intermediary, for the purpose of fixing prices, discounts, or terms of trade;
- (b) To discontinue the practice of promulgating jointly with any other supplier, or arranging to be promulgated jointly, price lists or other notifications of selling prices, discounts, or terms of trade;
- (c) To refrain from reviving these practices in any form whatsoever, or from entering into any other agreement or arrangement which would have substantially the same effect; and
- (d) To be individually responsible hereafter for the compilation of any price lists, or other notifications of prices, discounts, and terms of sale, issued in respect of the company's products.
