The Boundaries of Taupo County and Taupo Borough Altered

THE RIGHT HON. J. R. MARSHALL, PRESIDING IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to the Local Government Commission Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. The area described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby excluded from the district of the County of Taupo and included in the district of the Borough of Taupo.

2. That piece of land described in the Second Schedule hereto, vested in the corporation of the County of Taupo, is hereby vested in the corporation of the Borough of Taupo, in fee simple as and for the construction of certain waterworks, under the provisions of Part XVII of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954.

3. The District Land Registrar of the South Auckland Land District is hereby directed to make such entries in his Register, and to do all such other things as may be necessary to give effect to the provisions contained herein.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Taupo County, containing 189 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at a point on the right bank of the Waikato River, situated in Block II, Tauhara Survey District in line with the generally north-eastern boundary of part Lot 1, D.P. 8698, and proceeding north-westerly along a right line to and along the last-mentioned boundary and its production to and generally north-westerly along the generally north-eastern boundary of part Nukuhau Block, as shown on D.P. 8698, to the easternmost corner of part Lot 5, D.P. 8698; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of that part Lot 5, aforesaid, and its production to the generally north-western side of Acacia Bay Road; thence generally north-easterly along that roadside to, and north-westerly along, the north-eastern boundary of part Rangatira 8A 5C 5 Block to its northernmost corner; thence generally easterly along the generally northern boundary of the Taupo Central Block and its production, crossing two intervening public roads, to the generally eastern side of State Highway No. 1; thence generally southerly along that side to, and generally south-westerly along the right bank of the Waikato River, aforesaid, being the boundary of Taupo Borough, as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1964, page 2272, to the point of commencement.

Except as otherwise provided herein, or in the Local Government Commission Act 1961, the provisions of the Counties Act 1956 shall, with the necessary modifications, and so far as they are applicable, apply to the union hereby effected, as if the Borough of Palmerston were a dependent town district to which section 28 of the Counties Act 1956 applies; and the District Land Registrar for the Otago Land Registration District is hereby directed to make such entries in his Register, and to do all such other things as may be necessary to give effect to the provisions of this clause.

11. All the valuation rolls, electors lists, electors rolls, and rate books in force in the Borough of Palmerston on the 31st day of March 1967 shall continue in force, and be deemed to be the valuation rolls, electors lists, electors rolls, and rate books in force in the Palmerston Riding of the said county until new valuation rolls, electors lists, electors rolls, and rate books are made for the Palmerston Riding.

- (vii) The Incholme Riding, comprising the Incholme Riding of the former County of Waitaki.
- (viii) The Kakanui Riding, comprising the Kakanui Riding of the former County of Waitaki.
- (ix) The Otepopo Riding, comprising the Otepopo Riding of the former County of Waitaki.

4. For representation purposes, the said county shall be divided into seven ridings, as follows:

- (i) The Palmerston Riding, comprising the area contained in the district of the former Borough of Palmerston.
- (ii) The Bushey Riding, comprising the Bushey Riding of the former County of Waihemo.
- (iii) The Goodwood Riding, comprising the Goodwood Riding of the former County of Waihemo.
- (iv) The Green Valley Riding, comprising the Green Valley Riding of the former County of Waihemo.
- (v) The Macraes Riding, comprising the Macraes Riding of the former County of Waihemo.
- (vi) The Dunback Riding, comprising the Dunback Riding of the former County of Waihemo.
- (vii) The Blue Mountain Riding, comprising the Blue Mountain Riding of the former County of Waihemo.

5. The Council of the said county shall consist of nine members, as follows:

Except as otherwise provided herein, or in the Local Government Commission Act 1961, the provisions of the Counties Act 1956 shall, with the necessary modifications, and so far as they are applicable, apply to the union hereby effected, as if the Borough of Hampden were a dependent town district to which section 28 of the Counties Act 1956 applies; and the District Land Registrar for the Otago Land Registration District is hereby directed to make such entries in his Register, and to do all such other things as may be necessary to give effect to the provisions of this clause.

9. All the valuation rolls, electors lists, electors rolls, and rate books in force in the Borough of Hampden on the 31st day of March 1967 shall continue in force, and be deemed to be the valuation rolls, electors lists, electors rolls, and rate books in force in that part of the Moeraki Riding comprising the former Borough of Hampden until new valuation rolls, electors lists, electors rolls, and rate books are made for the Moeraki Riding.

The Manukau City Foreshore Control Order 1967

ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 165 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Manukau City Foreshore Control Order 1967.

(2) This order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. In this order—

“The Council” means the Manukau City Council;

“Foreshore” means such parts of the bed, shore, or banks of a tidal water as are covered and uncovered by the flow and ebb of the tide at ordinary spring tides;

“Minister” means the Minister of Marine, and includes any officer, person, or authority acting by, or under the direction or authority of, the Minister.

3. There is hereby granted to the Council, for a period of 21 years from the commencement of this order, the control of the foreshore described in the First Schedule to this order, subject to the provisions of section 165 of the Harbours Act 1950, and to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule to this order.

4. The Order in Council, made on 4 November 1964*, granting control of the foreshore fronting Beachlands - Te Puru and Omana-Maraetai to the Council is hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL the foreshore of the City of Manukau, excepting thereout foreshore lying within Auckland Harbour Limits.

SECOND SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS

1. Her Majesty or the Governor-General, and all officers in the Government service acting in the execution of their duty, shall at all times have free ingress, passage, and egress into, over, and out of the foreshore described in the First Schedule to this order, without payment.

2. Nothing herein contained shall authorise the Council to do, or cause to be done, anything repugnant to, or inconsistent with, any law relating to the Customs, or with any regulation of the Minister of Customs, or with any provision of the Harbours Act 1950 or its amendments, or any regulations made thereunder that are, or may hereafter be, in force.

3. The rights, powers, and privileges conferred by the Order in Council shall not apply to those portions of the foreshore required for securing the shore ends of any telegraph cables that are at present, or may be at any time, laid down within the said area of the foreshore.

4. The Council may enclose any part or parts of the foreshore described in the First Schedule hereto for the purpose of holding athletic sports or games, and may, by bylaws, fix a charge for admission to such enclosed part or parts: Provided that the total number of days on which such enclosures are made shall not exceed six in any one year.

5. Nothing herein contained shall authorise the Council to remove, or cause to be removed, any stone, sand, shingle, or shells without the consent of the Minister being first obtained.

6. The said rights, powers, and privileges may be at any time resumed by the Governor-General, without payment or any compensation whatever, on giving to the Council six calendar months' notice in writing. Any such notice shall be sufficient if given by the Minister and delivered at, or posted to, the last-known address of the Council in New Zealand.

“The Act” means the Exhibitions Act 1910;

Subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule hereto, the following provisions are hereby suspended in so far as they relate to work done or business conducted or services rendered in the said premises during the period of the exhibition, by or on behalf of the promoter, or by or on behalf of any exhibitor at the exhibition, or by any person employed in or about the exhibition, namely—such of the provisions of—

(a) The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954 and all awards and industrial agreements in force thereunder;

(b) The Shops and Offices Act 1955; and

(c) The Factories Act 1946

as relate to the hours of commencing or ceasing work, or to the issue of permits, or to the payment for overtime, or extended hours, or to holidays, and half holidays, or to the closing of shops.

SCHEDULE

1. Forty hours shall constitute a week's work, to be worked on five days of the week, and eight hours shall constitute a day's work in or about the exhibition, and, with the exception set out in clause 2 hereof, the daily hours shall be worked consecutively.

2. No person shall be employed in or about the exhibition for more than four hours without an interval of at least three-quarters of an hour for a meal.

3. (a) Any person employed during any day in or about the exhibition who is employed on that day for more than eight hours, or before the hour of 8 a.m., or after the hour of 10.30 p.m., or on any day in excess of five days per week (whether the excess employment is in or about the exhibition or otherwise) shall be paid for the excess employment at not less than half as much again as the ordinary rate for the first two hours and at not less than twice the ordinary rate thereafter.

(b) Any person employed in or about the exhibition on any day that would, but for the provisions of this order, have been a whole holiday for that person by virtue of any Act or of any award or industrial agreement shall be paid for all work done on that day at not less than twice the ordinary rate, whether the work is performed wholly in or about the exhibition or otherwise: Provided that nothing in this sub-clause shall be deemed to deprive any person of any other payment for the said holiday to which he is entitled under any Act or award or industrial agreement.

4. No male under 18 years of age and no female shall be employed in or about the exhibition after the hour of 10.30 p.m.

5. For the purposes of the enforcement of an award or industrial agreement, any provision of which has been suspended by this order, any officer of the industrial union or association concerned who is authorised in writing in that behalf by the union or association shall be entitled to interview at his place of employment any person employed in or about the exhibition under that award or industrial agreement at such time or times as may be agreed upon between the officer and the employer of that person, and for this purpose any such officer shall be entitled at any time to have access to the register of passes issued by the promoter.

6. Nothing in this notice shall be deemed to affect any provisions in an award or industrial agreement requiring workers subject to the award or industrial agreement to be members of a union.
