Notice to Make Returns of Income Under the Land and Income Tax Act 1954

administrators, notwithstanding that by reason of a loss being incurred for the year or carried forward from a previous year, no taxation is payable.

(b) Every person whose total income exceeded £1,300.

(c) Every person who derived interest and/or investment or building society dividends over £30 in the aggregate and whose total income (after deducting £30 of that interest and/or investment or building society dividends) exceeded £104.

(d) Every person who derived assessable income other than income from employment and whose total income

income from employment and whose total income exceeded £104. (Except in the case of persons mentioned in (a) above, no return is required where—

(i) The total income did not exceed £468 and consisted exclusively of income from employment together with Universal Superannuation and/or company dividends or

consisted exclusively of income from employment together with Universal Superannuation and/or company dividends, or

(ii) The total income did not exceed £468 and consisted exclusively of Universal Superannuation and/or company dividends.)

(e) Every person who paid provisional tax in respect of income for the year ended 31 March 1967.

(f) Every person to whom section 104 of the Land and Income Tax Act 1954 applies. Section 104 relates to aggregate assessments of husbands and wives and in general terms now applies only where—

(i) Income is derived by one spouse under a transfer or settlement of income by the other spouse and the assets producing the income are retained by or can revert to the other spouse.

(ii) Income is diverted from one to the other by permitting the use of assets or by the performance of services.

(h) Every unincorporated body which derived assessable income.

income.

(i) Every absentee who derived income from New Zealand.

2. Returns are required to be furnished by posting or delivering the same to the office of the Inland Revenue Department nearest to the place of residence of the taxpayer, or if the taxpayer's records are held in another office of the Department, then to the latter office.

3. Returns are due on:

(a) 7 June 1967 where income was derived from salary, wages, superannuation (not Universal), pensions, taxable

(a) 7 June 1967 where income was derived from salary, wages, superannuation (not Universal), pensions, taxable allowance, etc., and—

(i) No other income whatsoever was derived, or
(ii) The other income derived consisted exclusively of not more than £50 in total from dividends, net rents, interest (after £30 exemption).
(b) 7 August 1967 in all other cases or within two months of balance date, whichever is the later. No action for failure to furnish a return due on 7 August 1967 will be taken if it is furnished by 7 September 1967.
The return to be used is I.R. 5 (green print) in the case of paragraph 3 (a) above, although a more simple I.R. 5w may be used by salary, wage earners, or superannuitants with no other income or, if the only other income is interest of £30 or less, provided that all earnings and exemptions are shown in the tax deduction certificates. The I.R. 3 return or the I.R. 14 should be used in all other cases.
In addition to I.R. 3, farmers are to complete supplementary return I.R. 3F and persons in business or in a profession are to complete supplementary return I.R. 3B. Companies are to use I.R. 4 and estates and trusts I.R. 5A. Each form indicates the classes of taxpayers who are to use that form and, where applicable, the due dates for payment of provisional tax. Generally the first instalment of provisional tax must accompany the return when furnished and is due on 7 August 1967. It must be paid on or before 7 September 1967 in order to avoid the 10 percent additional tax for late payment. The second instalment is, in general, due on 7 February 1968 with a 10 percent additional tax if not paid by 7 March 1968. In some cases a third instalment is, in general, due on 7 May 1968 with a 10 percent additional tax if not paid by 7 June 1968. Taxpayers who are not required to furnish (and do not furnish) a final return by the expiration of one month

after the due date for payment of the first instalment of provisional tax, are required to furnish an interim return I.R. 5B unless they have been otherwise advised. This return is to be furnished not later than one month after the due date for payment of the first instalment of provisional tax. Fuller details are given in the interim return form.

4. All return forms are available at district offices of the Taxes Section, Inland Revenue Department, and forms other than interim return forms, are also available at post offices. Company returns are available at post offices in urban areas with a population of 5,000 or more not having an Inland Revenue District Office.

5. Any person or company failing to furnish a return within the prescribed time is liable to a fine not exceeding £100 and not less than £2.

an adjustment:

(a) Because he paid life insurance premiums.

(b) Because he considers that tax deductions made from his income were excessive.

(c) Because he was entitled to exemptions which were not included in his tax code during the year.

7. Any person furnishing a return of income who derived income taxed at time of payment should securely attach all tax deduction certificates (I.R. 12, I.R. 13, or I.R. 55) to the

Notes on the Weather for March 1967

General: March was cloudy and warm with an unusually high frequency of north-easterly winds. Over almost all the North Island moisture was adequate, as in previous months, and growth was unusually good in many districts. On the other hand, in the South Island the dry conditions of previous months persisted, expecially in Otago and Southland, where the feed was getting short in some areas.

short in some areas.

Rainfall: Rainfall was above average over most of the North Island and in western and many inland districts of the South Island. It was more than double the average value on the Coromandel Peninsula, in parts of Waikato, and eastern Bay of Plenty, and also over most of Westland.

Rainfall was below average by 25 percent or more over most of Southland, North Otago, North Canterbury, and Marlborough; also parts of Taihape and South Taranaki.

During a thunderstorm at Whakatane on the evening of the 1st, very heavy rain was recorded—half an inch in 10 minutes, and 4 inches in two hours. Flooding caused some damage.

A spell of northerly winds from the 8th to the 10th with a slow-moving trough over the South Island caused persistent heavy rain on the West Coast and in the Alps, with totals over the three days of 20 inches and more. Serious flooding was reported in Greymouth. Flooding also occurred in parts of Bay of Plenty after heavy rain on the 23rd and 24th, with two-day rainfalls of up to 10 inches.

Temperatures: For the first time since March 1966 temperatures

Temperatures: For the first time since March 1966 temperatures were warmer than average over the whole country, mainly by 1-2 degrees. The warmest period was 4-11 March, in a spell of persistent northerly winds.

Sunshine: Sunshine was close to average or below average over the whole country. Greatest deficiencies of about 40 hours were recorded in Northland, Nelson, Gisborne, and Hawke's Bay.

Weather Sequence: At the beginning of the month a slow-moving trough was crossing the North Island with rain. Some thunder-storms were reported, and at Whakatane very heavy rain over a storms were reported, and at Whakatane very heavy rain over a period of a couple of hours caused flooding. As the trough moved away on the 2nd a depression developed to the north-east, and winds were mainly southerly, with still some rain in eastern districts of the North Island, Bay of Plenty, and Coromandel. On the following day an anticyclone covered most of the country but there was still some rain in Gisborne, Northland, and Auckland.

By the 4th an anticyclone was centred to the east of the Chatham Islands. Pressures were low over and to the south of the Tasman Sea and warm northerlies developed over most of the country, persisting with only slight interruption for about a week. On the 4th

sisting with only slight interruption for about a week. On the 4th and 5th a trough of low pressure brought rain to the greater part

of the South Island with some heavy falls in south Westland, while some light rain was still being reported on the east coast of Northland and in Auckland, Coromandel, and Gisborne. On the 6th and 7th winds were mainly north-easterly, with rain becoming heavier in some northern districts of the North Island and Gisborne but with an improvement in worther weather the falls. with an improvement in weather over most of the South Island. By the 8th the anticyclone was centred far to the east of the Chatham the 8th the anticyclone was centred far to the east of the Chatham Islands. As pressures fell once again over the south Tasman Sea winds became more northerly over the greater part of the country but remained north-easterly in northern districts. A depression from the north Tasman Sea moved towards Cook Strait and a trough of low pressure progressed slowly north-eastward over the South Island. Copious rain fell on the West Coast and in the Alps, with flooding at Greymouth. Most other districts received some rain, the main exceptions being Hawke's Bay and the Kaikoura Coast. On the 11th the trough reached the North Island and started to move more rapidly, while the weather cleared over the southern half of the South Island.

From the 12th to the 18th a large anticyclone crossed the country.

From the 12th to the 18th a large anticyclone crossed the country, with mainly fine weather. However, on the 17th increased westerlies in the south brought rain to Fiordland and the Southland coast.

in the south brought rain to Fiordland and the Southland coast. During the 19th a trough moved northward, to become stationary through Auckland on the following day. Rain commenced in the South Island soon covering most districts there, and spread to areas east of the ranges in the North Island. On the 21st and 22nd the trough was still stationary, while a depression lay off the west coast of Northland. The rain then spread to northern districts of the North Island, but the weather cleared in the south. During the next two days the depression moved southward. The first trough moved off the country and another one crossed from west to east, with a change from north-easterly winds to northerlies or northmoved off the country and another one crossed from west to east, with a change from north-easterly winds to northerlies or north-westerlies. Rain now covered the whole of the North Island and also western and northern districts of the South Island. Some heavy falls were recorded in Coromandel, Bay of Plenty, and Taupo, with flooding in places. The weather cleared in most districts on the 25th with rising pressures. The main exceptions were Fiordland and south Westland, Southland, and Gisborne.

An anticyclone brought fine weather on the 26th. During the next three days the weather remained fine over most of the country. However, with pressures low to the north, easterlies brought showers at times to parts of Gisborne, Coromandel, and Northland.

On the last two days of the month the greater part of the South Island was affected by a slow-moving trough. Showers were also still reported from Northland.
