ORDER 1. This order may be cited as the Buller Electric Power Board Water Power and Electric Lines Licence 1967. 2. Subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, the Buller Electric Power Board (hereinafter referred to as "the licensee") is hereby granted a licence to obstruct, impound, or divert the waters of Christmas Creek, Lake Creek, and Lake Rochfort (hereinafter referred to as "the said waters") to raise or lower the levels thereof, and to take and use therefrom, for the purpose hereinafter set forth, streams of water (hereinafter referred to as "the said streams") not exceeding 60 cu. ft. per second at any one time from Lake Creek, and 30 cu. ft. per second at any one time from Lake Rochfort, and also to lay, construct, put up, place, and use electric lines and to construct electric works which may from time to time be required for the distribution and supply of electricity within the area described in the First Schedule hereto. Schedule hereto

supply of electricity within the area described in the First Schedule hereto. 3. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Water Power Regulations 1934 and the Electric Supply Regulations 1967 shall be incorporated herein and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this licence. 4. This licence is subject to the Water Power Regulations 1934, the Electrical Supply Regulations 1967, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961, and the Radio Interference Regu-lations 1958, and to all regulations made in amendment thereof, or in substitution therefor, except in so far as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this licence. 5. The said streams shall be taken from the said waters at the points indicated by red lines on the plan marked N.Z.E.D. 738 deposited in the office of the New Zealand Electricity Department at Wellington, and shall be used solely for the purpose of generating electricity. 6. The licensee is hereby authorised, subject to the con-ditions hereof, to construct, maintain, and use the works described in the Second Schedule hereto, the position of the said works being indicated on the said plan. 7. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), and (h) of regulation 15 of the Electric Supply Regulations 1967. 8. Nothing in this licence shall of itself be deemed to confer upon the licensee any right to water. 9. This licence shall, unless sooner lawfully determined, continue in force until the 23rd day of February 1988.

Wholesalers' Prices

4. The maximum price that may be charged or received by any wholesaler for any nails to which this order applies shall be determined as follows:

- (a) For nails sold by a wholesaler whose place of business is situate in any of the cities of Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, Dunedin, plus Palmerston North for 7 to 16 gauge nails only, the maximum wholesale price shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto:
- (b) For nails sold by any other wholesaler, the maximum wholesale price shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto increased by a proportionate part of any freight charges incurred by the wholesaler in obtaining delivery into his premises.

Retailers' Prices

5. The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any nails to which this order applies shall be determined as follows:

- (a) For nails sold by a retailer whose place of business is situate in any of the cities of Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, Dunedin, plus Palmerston North for 7 to 16 gauge nails only, the maximum retail price shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto:
- (b) For nails sold by any other retailer, the maximum retail price shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto increased by a proportionate part of any freight charges paid by the retailer to the wholesaler from whom the nails were purchased or incurred by the retailer in obtaining delivery into his premises.

6. If in respect of any lot of nails sold by a retailer the maximum retail price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this order is not an exact number of cents, the maximum price of the lot shall be calculated to the nearest whole cent.

- (c) The income from the fund referred to in clause (a) to be expended in purchasing a prize for the competition, and the surplus to be expended in purchasing books for the Wanganui Girls' College Library dealing with animals and animal life.
