Attending ANZUS Council Meeting and Seven Nations

official staff of a foreign envoy:

- (a) Every representative of each of the said Governments
(other than the Government of New Zealand) shall
be treated as if he were a foreign envoy; and
- (b) All the members of the official staff of any such repre-
sentative shall be treated as if they were members
of the official staff of a foreign envoy.
