"In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 23 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, the Mount Albert Borough Council hereby resolves, by way of special order, as follows:

- The present subdivision of the borough into five wards shall be revoked and in lieu thereof the borough shall be redivided into five wards known respectively as A, B, C, D, and E wards, as described in the Schedule hereto, which Schedule also redefines the boundaries of the borough.
- Exclusive of the Mayor, the Mount Albert Borough Council shall continue to consist of 10 members, 2 of whom shall be elected by each of the five wards in the said borough, known as A, B, C, D, and E.
- The division of the borough of Mount Albert shall be for the purposes of representation only.
