The other three shall retire on the 1st day of December 1924 and three persons shall be appointed in their places (the retiring trustees being eligible for reappointment). Every trustee hereafter appointed or reappointed in pursuance of the foregoing provisions of this subclause shall hold office for six (6) years from the date of his appointment and shall be eligible for reappointment. Harold Arthur Roland Dunderdale, Geoffrey Harold Blundell, John Harold Tremaine Maunsell, Joseph James Payton, and Edmund David Watts being at present trustees shall remain in office, but shall retire on the 31st day of December 1968 and upon such retirement a like number of trustees shall be appointed in their place. The retiring trustees shall be eligible for reappointment. In addition, not less than two nor more than five persons shall be appointed trustees from time to time so that the total number of trustees shall be not less than 12 nor more than 15.
