THE cover of this paperback book describes its contents as "forty-two of America's livliest [sic.] folk-songs, ribald and rowdy". Certainly they belong to a strong tradition of popular balladry marked at times by a coarseness far in excess of anything in the present collection. For although some of the songs here presented are unaffectedly crude, all are widely known, communally sung, and, given an appropriate social context, within the bounds of decency. The book is printed on cheap paper in minuscule type, with elementary musical settings and simple line drawings; it is inexpensive and its sale may be wide. The contents of the book, however, are not such as to justify any restriction and we accordingly decide that the book is not indecent.

#### (Price Order No. 2102 (Jamaican Oranges)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, I, Clifford Ernest Beard, pursuant to a delegation from the Secretary of Industries and Commerce acting under a delegation from the Price Tribunal, hereby make the following price order:

- 1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 2102 and shall come into force on the 10th day of April 1969.
  - 2. (1) Price Order 2073\* is hereby revoked
- (2) The revocation of the said order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this order.
- 3. References in this order to metropolitan references to the metropolitan areas described in the Schedule

#### APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

4. This order applies with respect to all Jamaican oranges sold by way of retail in New Zealand.

#### MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES

- 5. (1) Subject to the provisions of this clause, the maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any Jamaican oranges shall be—
  - (a) When sold by a retailer carrying on business in any of the metropolitan areas of Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, or Dunedin, or in any of the Cities or Boroughs of Whangarei, Takapuna, Hamilton, Tauranga, Rotorua, Gisborne, New Plymouth, Stratford, Hawera, Wanganui, Palmerston North, Napier, Hastings, Blenheim, Nelson, Greymouth, Timaru, Westport, Oamaru, Balclutha, Gore, or Invercargill— 16 cents per pound.
- (b) When sold by a retailer carrying on business elsewhere-

1 lb, 17 cents; 2 lb, 33 cents; 3 lb, 50 cents; 4 lb, 66 cents;

5 lb, 83 cents; 6 lb, 99 cents.

Fractions of a pound shall be calculated at 17 cents per pound. Quantities in excess of 6 lb shall be calculated at the rate of  $16\frac{1}{2}$  cents per pound.

(2) If in respect of any lot of oranges sold by a retailer the maximum price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause is not an exact number of cents the maximum price of the lot may be computed to the nearest whole cent.

#### SPECIAL PRICES WHERE EXTRAORDINARY CHARGES INCURRED

6. Subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the 6. Subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any retailer, may authorise special prices in respect of any Jamaican oranges to which this order applies where special circumstances exist, or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any authority given by the Tribuna under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lo or consignment of oranges or may relate generally to all Jamaican oranges to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force.

#### DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS

- 7. Every retailer who offers or exposes any Jamaican orange for sale in any shop shall keep in a prominent position in such proximity to the oranges to which it relates as to be obviously descriptive thereof, a ticket, placard, or label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the following particulars:
  - (a) The retail price of the oranges. Retailers to whom clause 5 (1) (b) of this order applies shall state at least the prices for 1 lb and 2 lb lots.
    (b) The word "Jamaican".
