*Revoking a Proclamation Declaring Areas in the Waitaki Valley  
Acclimatisation District to be Wildlife Refuges*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting on the joint recommendation of the Minister of Internal Affairs and the Minister of Lands (being the Minister charged with the administration of the department of State having the control of the land of the Crown affected by this Proclamation), hereby revoke the Proclamation issued on the 28th day of March 1963\*, declaring areas of land in the Canterbury and Otago Land Districts, in the Waikato Valley Acclimatisation District, to be wildlife refuges for the purposes of the wildlife Act 1953; as shown on plan marked I.A. 46/29/55 deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, and thereon edged blue.

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1947, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the middle line of a further portion of the Ngauranga - Basin Reserve Motorway shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall affect only the lands situated within the limits of the area shown, edged red, on the plan marked M.O.W. 23292 (sheets 1 to 3) referred to in the said Schedule.

*Landscaping (2)*—Water features and waterway excavation, grading and shaping banks, connecting pipes and outlets. As the waterway runs through the length of the park, it is a main feature, setting off the group planting of trees (\$7,500).

*Pathways*—Circulating pathways and bridges to lead over waterways to tree groves and picnic areas (\$5,750).

*Drainage*—General drainage, storm water and draining low-lying areas (\$13,700).

*Equipment*—Maintenance equipment, tractor, mowing equipment, truck or trailer, tools, etc. (\$5,500).

*Service House*—A house is necessary for a park attendant to protect this area and to attend to the work and the development and maintenance of the park (\$11,000).
