Crown Land and Provisional State Forest Land Set Apart as Permanent State Forest Land

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 18 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby set apart the Crown land and provisional State forest land described in the Schedules hereto as permanent State forest land.

Waiheke Road District Abolished and Waiheke County Constituted

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of March 1970

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Local Government Commission Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1970.

2. The Waiheke Road District is hereby abolished and the Board of the said road district is hereby dissolved.

3. The areas of land described in the First Schedule hereto shall be constituted a county, to be known as the County of Waiheke (hereinafter called "the said county").

4. The said county shall be divided into three ridings, with the following names and boundaries.

(a) The Central Riding, comprising all those areas contained in the former Waiheke Road District, together with the neighbouring islands of Papakohata (Crusoe Island), Motuihe, Rangitoto, and Motutapu; as described in the Second Schedule hereto.

(b) The North Riding, comprising all those areas contained in the neighbouring islands of South, Rakino, The Noises (Motuhoropapa, Orarapa (The Haystack), and Otata Islands), David Rocks (The Four Islands), and Maria (Ruapuke Island); as described in the Third Schedule hereto.

(c) The East Riding, comprising all those areas contained in the neighbouring islands of Tarahiki (Shag), Pakatoa, Rotoroa, Ponui, Pakihi, and Karamurama, as described in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

5. Separate accounts shall be kept for each riding of the said county and, for rating purposes, the Council of the said county shall, for a period of 10 years, or for such longer period as the Council shall resolve by special order, apply the provisions of subsection (1) of section 110 of the Counties Act

1956 as if the ridings described in clause 4 of this order had been counties immediately prior to the date of this order.

6. For a period of 10 years from 1 April 1970 or such longer period as the Council of the said county may resolve by special order, the provisions of subsections (2), (3), and (4) of section 61 of the Counties Amendment Act 1968 shall, as far as they are applicable and with the necessary modifications, apply as if the North Riding and the East Riding were county towns within the meaning of the said Act.

7. The Council of the said county shall consist of nine members, as follows:

For the Central Riding—seven members
For the North Riding — one member
For the East Riding — one member

8. The first election of the members of the Council of the said county shall be held on the date prescribed by law for the first triennial general election of members of county councils to be held after the 1st day of April 1970.

9. (a) Until the members of the Council of the said county, elected at the said first election, shall come into office, the Council of the said county shall consist of the nine members of the Waiheke Road Board holding office immediately prior to its dissolution; and at its first meeting the said Council shall appoint from among its members one member to represent the North Riding and one member to represent the East Riding.

(b) In the event of any vacancy occurring on the Council of the said county prior to the next triennial general elections of members of county councils, such vacancy may be filled by the appointment of a member to be nominated by the Waiheke County Council.

10. The Waiheke County Council shall, pursuant to section 71 of the Counties Act 1956, appoint a special advisory committee of four persons, two of whom shall be electors of the North Riding and two of whom shall be electors of the East Riding, who shall continue as members of the said committee until the first election, as provided in clause 8 of this order.

11. The farm-land roll made or continuing in force under Part VI of the Rating Act 1967 in the former Waiheke Road District shall continue in force until a new farm-land roll for that portion of the Central Riding is made.

12. Upon the commencement of this order:

(a) All property, real or personal, belonging to the Corporation of the former Waiheke Road District shall become vested in the Corporation of the said county.

(b) All rates or other money payable to the former Waiheke Road Board shall become due and payable to the Council of the said county.

(c) All actions, suits, and proceedings pending by or against the Corporation of the former Waiheke Road Board may be carried on and prosecuted by or against the Corporation of the said county.

(d) All liabilities, contracts, and engagements of the former Waiheke Road Board shall become liabilities, contracts, and engagements of the Council of the said county.

13. All balances and other amounts in respect to the matters contained in clause 12 of this order standing in the accounts of the Waiheke Road Board upon its dissolution shall be debited, credited, or carried into, as the case may be, the appropriate accounts kept by the Council of the said county in respect of the Central Riding.

14. The cost of all special works to be carried out in any riding shall be debited against the appropriate separate account of the riding concerned.

15. Interest, sinking funds, and capital repayments in respect of all existing loans secured over the former Waiheke Road District shall remain as a charge and be debited against the appropriate separate account of the Central Riding.

16. All future district planning costs shall be debited against the appropriate separate account of the riding affected by such planning.

17. Subject to the provisions of clauses 14, 15, and 16 hereof, the following items shall be credited and debited to the appropriate separate account of either the Central, North, or East Riding, as the case may require.

(a) All land subdivision fees paid in respect of subdivisions made in the riding.

(b) All other income, grants, or subsidies collected within or arising from the riding.

(c) A proportionate part of the contributions, grants, and subscriptions paid by the Council of the said county to all special purpose authorities whose districts include the said riding or part or parts thereof.

(d) All other expenditure in, or in connection with, the riding.

18. All the valuation rolls, electors lists, electors rolls, and rate books in force in the existing Waiheke Road District shall continue in force in the new county until the new valuation rolls, electors lists, electors rolls, and rate books respectively are made for the said county, pursuant to the Counties Act 1956.

19. All bylaws in force in the former Waiheke Road District shall become the bylaws of the said county until new bylaws are made pursuant to the Counties Act 1956.

20. All existing staff of the former Waiheke Road Board shall be taken over by the Council of the said county under, and subject to, the provisions of the Local Authorities (Employment Protection) Act 1963. This provision shall be in extension of, and subject to, the provisions of the said Act.

21. The first county clerk of the said county shall be the Clerk of the former Waiheke Road Board.

22. So far as they are applicable and with the necessary modifications, the provisions of section 99A of the Land Transfer Act 1952 shall apply to the constitution of the said county.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District containing 60 square miles, more or less, comprising all those areas of land above mean high-water mark being the islands of Rangitoto, Motutapu, Rakino, Motuihe, Waiheke, Rotoroa, Ponui, Pakihi, Karamurama, and other adjacent islands or islets as contained within the area bounded by a line commencing at a point of 174° 49' east longitude, 36° 40' south latitude, and proceeding easterly along that parallel of latitude to 175° 15' east longitude; thence southerly along that line of longitude to 36° 54' south latitude; thence south-westerly along a right line to a point 20 chains due south of Karamurama Island; thence north-westerly along a right line to a point of 175° 1' east longitude, 36° 50' south latitude, along another right line to a point of 174° 49' east longitude, 36° 49' south latitude; thence northerly along that line of 174° 49' east longitude to the point of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE

ALL that area of Waiheke County comprising the islands of Rangitoto, Motutapu, Motuihe, Waiheke, and other adjacent islands or islets, as excluded from north and east ridings, as described in the Third and Fourth Schedules respectively.

THIRD SCHEDULE

ALL that area of Waiheke County comprising the islands of Rakino, The Noises, and other adjacent islands or islets lying to the north-east of the middle of Rakino Channel, but excluding D'Urville Rocks.

FOURTH SCHEDULE

ALL that area of Waiheke County comprising the islands of Tarahiki, Pakatoa, Rotoroa, Ponui, Pakihi, and other adjacent islands or islets lying to the east of the middle of Waiheke Channel.

Redefining the Limits of the Harbour of Tauranga

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby redefines the outward sea limits of the harbour of Tauranga to be as described in the First Schedule to this order, and defines the inwards limits of the harbour of Tauranga to be as described in the Second Schedule to this order.

FIRST SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF OUTWARD SEA LIMITS

Katikati Harbour—

By a right line commencing at Trig. 69, Block XIII, Katikati Survey District, and extending at a bearing of 341° for a distance of 2 nautical miles; thence by an arc of 2 nautical miles radius centred on Trig. 69 extending in a clockwise direction to mean high-water mark at Matakana Island.

Tauranga Harbour—

By a right line bearing 0° 00' from mean high-water mark at Mount Maunganui to North Rock Light; thence by a right line bearing 93° from North Rock Light to a point 2 nautical miles distant from Trig. A; thence by an arc of 2 nautical miles radius centred on Trig. A extending in an anticlockwise direction to mean high-water mark at Matakana Island.

Maketu Estuary—

By a right line extending across the mouth of the estuary at a bearing of 295° from Trig. F. (Maketu).

Waihi Estuary—

By a right line extending across the mouth of the estuary at a bearing of 75° from Trig. F. (Maketu).

SECOND SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF INWARDS LIMITS

1. The waters of the Wairoa River downstream of the seawards side of the Wairoa Bridge of State Highway No. 2; and

2. All tidal waters within the limits defined in the First Schedule to this order; excepting thereout the Wairoa River, the inwards limit of which is defined in paragraph 1 of the Second Schedule to this order.

Exempting Lands in the Westland Land District from the Operation of Part III of the Coal Mines Act 1925

(2) This notice shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. There shall be a Board of Governors to be known as the Council of the Auckland Technical Institutes.

3. (1) The Council of the Auckland Technical Institutes shall be constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the Auckland City Council;
- (b) One member appointed by the Manukau City Council;
- (c) One member appointed by the Council of the University of Auckland;
- (d) One member appointed by the Auckland Branch of the New Zealand Institute of Architects;
- (e) One member appointed by the Auckland Branch of the New Zealand Institution of Engineers;
- (f) One member appointed by the Auckland Branch of the New Zealand Society of Accountants;
- (g) Three members appointed by the associations of employers in local industries;
- (h) Three members appointed by the associations of employees in local industries;
- (i) Four members to be co-opted by the Council itself, if and when it thinks fit.

(2) The Superintendent of Education, Auckland, or his deputy, shall be an associate member of the Council, entitled to be present at any meeting of the Council or of any committee of the Council, and to speak at the meeting; but he shall not be entitled to vote at any such meeting.

4. The Council of the Auckland Technical Institutes shall control the Auckland Technical Institute.

5. The Council of the Auckland Technical Institutes shall, for the time being, also control the Manukau Technical Institute.
