PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, I, the Right Hon. Sir Herbert Richard Churton Wild, the Administrator of the Government of New Zealand, hereby define the boundaries of the Bay of Plenty Electric Power District as set out in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the South Auckland and Gisborne Land Districts, the Tauranga, Rotorua, Waipua, Waikohu, Wairoa, Whakatane, and Opotiki Counties, and the Whakatane, Kawerau, Opotiki, and Murupara Boroughs bounded by a line commencing at Trig. Station 2126, Maungapohatu, in Block XII, Ruatahuna Survey District, being a point on the south-eastern boundary of Whakatane County, and proceeding south-easterly, south-westerly, and northerly along the former Whakatane County boundary, as described in *Gazette*, 1962, page 867, to the intersection of a right line between Trig. Station 31, Paeroa, in Block V, Paeroa Survey District, and Trig. Station 2120, Tawhiwhau, in Block XIV, Galatea Survey District, and the production southerly of a right line between Trig. Station 18, Maungawhakamana, in Block III, Ruawahia Survey District, and Trig. Station 38, Ahiwhakamura, in Block X, Kaingaroa Survey District; thence westerly along a right line towards Trig. Station 31, aforesaid, to the eastern boundary of Section 1, Block IX, Kaingaroa Survey District; thence northerly along that boundary to its north-easternmost point; thence along a right line towards Trig. Station Te Rere on the southern boundary of Block II, Kaingaroa Survey District, to the middle of the Ngatamawahine Stream; thence north-easterly down the middle of that stream to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of part Run 54, as shown on S.O. Plan 35574; thence to and along that boundary and the eastern and northern boundaries of that run to the south-eastern boundary of part Pokohu C. 1; thence north-easterly along that boundary to its easternmost point; thence along a right line to the north-eastern corner of Block XV, Ruawahia Survey District, and along another right line to the intersection of the southern boundary of Block VII, Ruawahia Survey District, and the western boundary of Whakatane County; thence northerly along that county boundary being along a right line to Trig. Station 18, aforesaid; thence north-easterly along a right line to the south-western corner of part Allotment 63, Matata Parish (provisional State forest, *Gazette*, 1920, page 2107), in Block XV, Rotoma Survey District; thence northerly along the western boundaries of that allotment and part Section 15, Block XI, Rotoma Survey District (scenic reserve, *Gazette*, 1927, page 2430), to the southern side of No. 30 State Highway; thence northerly along a right line being the original boundary of Matata Parish to the southern boundary of Block VII, Rotoma Survey District; thence westerly, northerly generally, and westerly again along that boundary and the southern boundary of Block VI, Rotoma Survey District, to and along the southern boundary of Section 5, Block VI, aforesaid, and the generally northern shore of Lake Rotoma to the eastern boundary of Rotoiti 10A (scenic reserve, *Gazette*, 1964, page 2262); thence along that boundary, along a right line to and again along that eastern boundary to its northernmost point; thence along the north-eastern boundary of Rotoiti 10B and its production to the generally south-western side of the Pongakawa Valley Road; thence north-westerly along that roadside to the northernmost corner of Section 8, Block VI, aforesaid; thence along a right line to the southernmost corner of State forest, *Gazette*, 1938, page 1687 (formerly Hannons Road); thence along the eastern boundary of that State forest to and along the north-western

boundaries of Sections 2 and 1A, Block II, Rotoma Survey District (State forest, *Gazette*, 1937, page 1711), and the last-mentioned boundary produced to and down the middle of the Waitahanui River to the northern boundary of Block X, Waihi South Survey District; thence easterly along that boundary and the northern boundary of Block XI, Waihi South Survey District, to the western boundary of Whakatane County; thence northerly along that boundary, being along a right line to the south-western corner of part Section 3, Block VII, Waihi South Survey District; thence northerly along the western boundary of part Section 3, aforesaid, to and along the eastern boundaries of part Lot 10 and Lot 11, part 13, 14, and 15, D.P. 8636, and Lot 6, D.P. 35929, to the southern side of No. 2 State Highway; thence northerly along a right line to and along the eastern boundary of part Lot 1, D.P. 8636, to the southern side of a public road; thence along a right line to and along the eastern boundaries of Waewaehikitia 3, 2A, 2B, and Urupa to the north-eastern corner of that Urupa; thence northerly along a right line to and along the eastern boundary of Waewaehikitia No. 1 to the shore of the Bay of Plenty; thence south-easterly and north-easterly along that shore to Potikirua in Block III, Whangaparaoa North Survey District, being the north-easternmost corner of Whangaparaoa part 2D and 2E 2B 1 Block; thence generally southerly and westerly along the eastern boundary of that block, crossing State Highway No. 35 and another intervening public road, along the north-eastern boundary of Section 1, Block I, Matakaoa West Survey District, the southern boundaries of the said Section 1 and Whangaparaoa part 2D and 2E 2B 2 Block, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Whangaparaoa River, up the middle of that river to a point in line with the middle of the Mangapouri Stream, to and up the middle of that stream to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 10599 (AK), to and along that boundary, the eastern boundaries of Lot 2, D.P. 10599 (AK), Lots 3 and 4, D.P. 10600 (AK), and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Waikura River, down the middle of that river to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 9472 (AK), to and along that boundary and the north-eastern boundary of Te Kumi No. 1 Block to Trig. Station Pakira in Block VIII, Raukumara East Survey District, along the south-eastern boundary of Te Kumi No. 1 Block to Trig. Station 1328, Honokawa, along a right line to Trig. Station Kopua in Block V, Hikorangi Survey District, along a right line to Trig. Station Arowhana in Block IV, Arowhana Survey District, approximately 14 chains along a right line in the direction of Trig. Station 139, Tuanui-o-te-Kahakaha (in Block X, Arowhana Survey District) to intersect the north-eastern boundary of Waipaoa 1E Block; thence north-westerly generally along the north-eastern and north-western boundaries of the last-mentioned block to and along the south-western boundary of Maungawaru No. 2 and 3 Block and its production to the middle of the Motu River in Block IX, Maungawaru Survey District; thence south-westerly generally up the middle of the Motu River to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of Section 2, Block II, Otipi Survey District, across a road reserve to and along that boundary and the south-eastern boundary of Section 6, Block IV, Urutawa Survey District, the eastern boundary of Section 2, Block VIII, Urutawa Survey District, the abutment of a road reserve, again along the eastern and south-western boundary of the said Section 2, to and along the south-eastern side of a public road, to the westernmost corner of Section 5, Block VIII, Urutawa Survey District, due south across Whinray Road to and along the south-eastern side of that road, to and along the south-eastern boundary of Section 3, Block II, Urutawa East Survey District, to and along the eastern side of Opotiki-Matawai via Motu Road to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 5, Block I, Urutawa East Survey District, to and along that boundary, the eastern boundaries of Sections 1 and 4, Block I, Urutawa East Survey District, the southern boundary of the last-mentioned boundary and its production to the middle of the Pakihi Stream, up the middle of that stream to a point in line with the easternmost portion of the northern boundary of Section 13, Block XIV, Urutawa Survey District, along that boundary and the generally eastern boundaries of that section and of Section 1, Block II, Motu West Survey District, to Trig. Station Pokaikiri in Block II, Motu West Survey District, along the south-eastern boundary of Section 5, Block I, Motu West Survey District, and its production across State Highway No. 2 to and along the south-eastern boundaries of Section 21, a public road, Lot 2 of Section 3, and Section 1, Block I, Motu West Survey District, the south-eastern boundaries of Oamaru part 2c Block, Section 1, Block XI, Moanui Survey District, Oamaru 1b and 1c Blocks, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the eastern boundary of Urewera A. *Defining the Boundaries of the Waimea Electric Power District and Outer Area*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, I, the Right Hon. Sir Herbert Richard Churton Wild, the Administrator of the Government of New Zealand, hereby define the boundaries of the Waimea Electric Power District and outer area as set out in the First and Second Schedules hereto respectively.

FIRST SCHEDULE

WAIMEA ELECTRIC POWER DISTRICT

ALL that area in the Nelson Land District containing all the Counties of Waimea and Murchison, part of the County of Inangahua, all the Boroughs of Motueka and Richmond, and part of the City of Nelson, bounded by a line commencing at Pukerau Point on the eastern sea coast of Tasman Bay and proceeding south-easterly along a right line to North Castor Peak; thence generally southerly and south-westerly along the summit of the Bryant Range through the Rai Saddle and Mount Duppa to the source of Heringa Creek on Saddle Hill; thence south-easterly down the middle of that creek to the middle of the Pelorus River; thence generally south-westerly up the middle of that river to its source on Slaty Peak; thence generally south-westerly along the summit of Bryant Range and Richmond Range passing through Old Man, Mount Rintoul, Bishops Cap, and Bushy Top to Wards Pass; again south-westerly along a right line to Trig. Station Top 2; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of Section 3, Square 34, and that boundary produced across provincial State Highway No. 63 to its southern side; thence south-westerly along the southern side of that highway to the westernmost corner of Section 6, Square 34; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of the said Section 6 to the south-eastern corner of Section 11, Block XIV, Motupiko Survey District; thence generally south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of the said Section 11 and the summit of the St. Arnaud Range to Mount St. Arnaud; again generally south-westerly along the summit of the St. Arnaud Range and the summit of the Spenser Mountains, passing through the Camel, Mount McKay, Mount Humbolt, Mount Una, and Faerie Queen, to the junction near Ada Pass of the summit of the Spenser Mountains with the summit of the watershed between the Glenroy and Maruia Rivers; thence generally westerly and northerly along the summit of the watershed between the Glenroy and Maruia Rivers to Mount Cann; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of Section 10, Block XIII, Matakitaki Survey District, and that boundary produced across a public road to its southern side; thence westerly along the southern side of the said public road to and along the southern boundary of Block XIII, Matakitaki Survey District, to the north-eastern corner of Block IV, Rahu Survey District; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of Rahu Survey District to its junction with the north-east corner of Block IV, Lewis Survey District; thence easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of Block I and the eastern boundary of Block IV, Travers Survey District, to a point on the summit of the Spenser Range; thence generally westerly along the summit of the Spenser Range and the southern watershed of the Maruia River to the western boundary of Block II, Lewis Survey District; thence northerly along the western boundary of Block II, Lewis Survey District, and Blocks XIV, X, VI, and II, Rahu Survey District, and Blocks XIV, X, VI, and II, Burnett Survey District, to the intersection of the last-mentioned boundary with the summit of the Brunner Range; thence generally northerly along the summit of the Brunner Range passing through Mount Pelion, Mount Wynn, and Trig. K. to a point due south of the confluence of the Eight Mile or Boundary Creek with the Buller River; thence due north along a right line to the mouth of the said Boundary Creek; thence generally northerly along

a leading spur on the western side of the said creek to Bald Hill; thence generally north-easterly along the summit of the Lyell Range passing through Trig. W. and Nugget Knob to the Wangapeka Saddle; thence generally north-easterly along the summits of the Arthur Range and Pikikiruna Range through Mount Luna, Mount Arthur, Lodestone, Crusader, Hoary Head, and Pikikiruna to a point on the western boundary of Section 1, Block XI, Totaranui Survey District, in line with the southern boundary of Section 5, Block X, Totaranui Survey District; thence due east to and along that boundary and its production to the sea coast of Tasman Bay; thence generally south-easterly along the sea coast, crossing the mouths of all harbours and inlets to a point on the high-water mark at Nelson City on the northern side of Rocks Road bearing 303° 42' from a point on the north-western side of Princes Drive bearing 333° 26' 17" distance 8315 links from Standard Survey Stone CLXIV (S.O. 8460); thence south-easterly along a right line to the said point on the north-western side of Princes Drive; thence south-westerly along the north-western side of the said Princes Drive to the northernmost corner of Lot 2, D.P. 5769; again south-westerly along the north-western boundary of the said Lot 2 and the north-western side of Princes Drive to a point in line with the south-western side of Boundary Road; thence south-easterly to and along the south-western side of the said Boundary Road and its production to the south-eastern side of Waimea Road; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern side of the said Waimea Road to the south-western side of Boundary Road; thence south-easterly along the south-western side of the said Boundary Road to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Section D. 3, District of Wakatu; thence south-easterly to and along the south-western boundary of the said Section D. 3, the south-western end of Tukuka Street, the south-western boundary of Section D. 21, District of Wakatu, the south-western end of Grampian Road, and the south-western boundaries of Section D. 28 and D. 29, District of Wakatu, to the northernmost corner of Section 7, District of Brook Street and Maitai; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundaries of the said Section 7 and Section 3 of 8, District of Brook Street and Maitai, to the westernmost corner of the said Section 3 of 8; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of the said Section 3 of 8 and that boundary produced to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of Section 1, District of Brook Street and Maitai; thence generally north-easterly to and along the south-eastern boundary of the said Section 1, the south-eastern and north-eastern boundaries of Section 35, and the south-eastern boundary of Section 36, District of Brook Street and Maitai, to the easternmost corner of the said Section 36; thence generally north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of parts of the said Section 36, Section 44, and Rural Section 1, District of Brook Street and Maitai, to the eastern boundary of Section B. 21, District of Wakatu; thence generally northerly along the south-eastern boundaries of the said Section B. 21 and Sections B. 20 and B. 19, District of Wakatu, the last-mentioned boundary produced across Manuka Street, the eastern boundaries of Sections B. 11, B. 10, B. 9, and B. 8, District of Wakatu, the last-mentioned boundary produced across Nile Street East, the eastern, northern, and eastern boundaries of Section B. 7, District of Wakatu, and the eastern boundary of the said Section B. 7 produced to the left bank of the Maitai River; thence generally easterly and northerly along the said left bank to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Section A. 8, District of Wakatu; thence north-westerly to and along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section A. 8 to the south-westernmost corner of Section 59, District of Suburban North; thence generally westerly along the southern, eastern, and southern boundaries of the said Section 59 and the eastern, southern, and western boundaries of Section 58, District of Suburban North, to the easternmost corner of Section 269A, City of Nelson; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section 269A, that boundary produced across Milton Street North, and along the north-eastern boundary of Section 259A, City of Nelson, to the south-eastern side of North Road; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern side of the said North Road to a point in line with the northern boundary of Section H. 9, District of Wakatu; thence westerly along the northern boundary of the said Section H. 9 to the easternmost corner of Section 1167, City of Nelson; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section 1167 to its northernmost point; thence north-westerly along a right line to a point on the south-eastern boundary of Section 1132, City of Nelson, in line with the centre of the lighthouse tower;
