WHEREAS the General Assembly of New Zealand stands prorogued to the 11th day of March 1971:

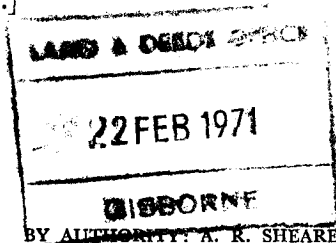
