PURSUANT to sections 8A and 165 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following Order.

## ORDER

1. (a) This Order may be cited as the Port Waikato Order 1971.

(b) This Order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. In this Order—

“The Act” means the Harbours Act 1950;

“The Council” means the Raglan County Council;

“Foreshore” means such parts of the bed, shore or banks of a tidal water as are covered and uncovered by the ebb and flow of the tide at ordinary spring tides;

“Minister” means the Minister of Marine and Fisheries; and includes any officer, person or authority acting by or under the direction or authority of the Minister.

3. There is hereby granted to the Council for a period of 21 years from the commencement of this Order, the control of foreshore and waters described in the First Schedule to this Order subject to the provisions of sections 8A and 165 of the Act, and to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

## DESCRIPTION OF FORESHORE AND WATERS

ALL the foreshore and waters of the Tasman Sea and the Waikato River bounded by a line commencing at high-water mark at a point in line with the extension of the western

boundary of Lot 2, D.P. S. 4761, thence due north into the Tasman Sea for a distance of 200 yards, thence generally northerly, at a distance of 200 yards from high-water mark to a point due north of the extremity of the southern spit at the mouth of the Waikato River, thence by a right line bearing 045° true to the opposite bank of the Waikato River, and then generally easterly by the line of low-water mark to a point bearing 315° from the most northerly point of Section 5 40422L and thence by a right line in a 135° direction to high-water mark on the opposite bank of the Waikato River, and thence generally westerly along the line of high-water mark to the point of commencement.

## SECOND SCHEDULE

## CONDITIONS

1. Her Majesty or the Governor-General and all officers in the Government service acting in the execution of their duty shall, at all times, have free ingress, passage, and egress into, over, and out of the foreshore and waters described in the First Schedule to this Order.

2. Nothing in this Order shall authorise the Council to do or cause to be done anything repugnant to or inconsistent with any law relating to the Customs or any provisions of the Harbours Act 1950, that is or may hereafter be in force.

3. The rights, powers, and privileges conferred by this Order in Council shall not apply to those portions of the foreshore required for securing the shore ends of any telegraph cables that are at present or may be at any time laid down within the area of foreshore described in the First Schedule to this Order.

4. The Council may enclose any part or parts of the foreshore described in the First Schedule to this Order for the purpose of holding sports meetings or games, and may, by bylaws, fix a charge for admission to any such enclosed part or parts: Provided that the total number of days on which any particular part of that foreshore is so enclosed shall not exceed 6 in any 1 calendar year.

5. Nothing in this Order shall authorise the Council to remove or cause to be removed from the foreshore described in the First Schedule to this Order any stone, sand, shingle, or shells without the consent in writing of the Minister being first obtained.

6. The rights, powers, and privileges conferred on the Council by this Order may be at any time resumed by the Governor-General, without payment or any compensation whatever, on giving to the Council at least 6 months' notice in writing. Any such notice shall be sufficient if given by the Minister and delivered at or posted to the Council at its public office.

PURSUANT to the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967 and the Local Government Commission Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. **Title**—This order may be cited as the Northland Catchment Area Order 1971.

2. **Extension of Northland Catchment Area**—The area described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the said area) is hereby included in Northland Catchment Area\*.

3. **Representation on Northland Catchment Commission**—For the purpose of representation on the Northland Catchment Commission there shall be appointed two further members from persons nominated by the local authorities in the said area, of whom one shall represent the counties in the said area and one shall represent the municipalities in the said area: Provided that the representation herein provided may be reviewed at the expiration of 12 months by the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Council.

4. **Special Provisions Affecting the Newly Included Area**—In respect of that part of the Northland Catchment Area that comprises the said area the following provisions shall apply:

- (a) The provisions of Part V of the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 shall not apply: Provided that they shall apply to the extent of any agreement to operate the whole or part of the said Part V made with the approval of the National Water and Soil Conservation Authority between the Northland Catchment Commission and any territorial local authority having jurisdiction in the said area in respect of the whole or any part of the district of that local authority.
- (b) The provisions of section 126 of the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 shall not apply: Provided that they shall apply to the extent of any agreement to operate the provisions of such section made with the approval of the National Water and Soil Conservation Authority between the Northland Catchment Commission and any territorial local authority having jurisdiction in the said area in respect of the whole or any part of the district of that local authority.
- (c) The provisions of subsection (2) of section 20 of the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967 shall be restricted to conform with the provisions of paragraphs (a) to (d) of this clause.
- (d) Each territorial local authority having jurisdiction in the said area shall pay by way of an annual contribution towards the administrative costs incurred by the Northland Catchment Commission in carrying out its functions under the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967 such sum or rate as may from time to time be fixed by any Act or regulation in that behalf and, until any such sum or rate has been so fixed the amount to be so paid shall be such sum as may be agreed upon between the territorial local authority and the Northland Catchment Commission; and in the event of failure of any said territorial local authority and the Northland Catchment Commission to agree on any such sum, then such sum as may be determined by the National Water and Soil Conservation Authority: In addition the Northland Catchment Commission may levy any of the said territorial local authorities having jurisdiction within the said area for the cost of any work undertaken or proposed to be undertaken for the purposes of the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967 as hereinbefore restricted; and the cost of such work may be increased by a percentage to provide for administrative and other expenses in respect of the work as more particularly described in subsection (2) of section 84 of the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 which for this purpose shall be read as if the references in that subsection were references to the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967, such percentage being from time to time determined by agreement between the North-

land Catchment Commission and the said territorial local authority: Provided that where an agreement as referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this sub-clause is entered into the provisions of this paragraph (d) shall cease to operate or shall be modified to ensure compliance with the terms of the agreement.

NOTES ON THE WEATHER FOR SEPTEMBER 1971

**General**—In contrast with previous months, September was marked by a greater frequency than normal of winds from a westerly quarter. It was also a warm month, especially in the east. Farmers found the weather too wet over the greater part of the North Island. On the other hand, in parts of Canterbury it was too dry.

Unusually violent north-westerly gales buffeted Canterbury and Otago on the 10th and 11th, with considerable damage in some inland districts.

**Rainfall**—Rainfall was above normal over the North Island north of Paraparamu and Masterton; and in the South Island on the West Coast and in the Alps, and in Southland and most of

Otago. In Waikato and parts of Bay of Plenty and in Central Hawke's Bay it was more than double the normal value.

In Nelson, Marlborough, most of Canterbury, and North Otago rainfall was below normal, being less than half in some coastal districts from north of Timaru to west of Nelson city.

**Temperatures**—Temperatures were 1° c above normal in eastern districts of both Islands but close to or only slightly above normal in the west.

**Sunshine**—West of the main ranges from Waikato to Manawatu sunshine was 20-50 hours below normal. It was also below normal on the Southland coast.

**Weather Sequence**—During the first 2 days of September a deep depression was moving away to the south-east and pressures were also low far to the south, while an anticyclone was centred to the north. Westerly to south-westerly conditions prevailed, with rain on the West Coast and Southland, besides parts of Canterbury and the whole of the North Island. Snow was reported on the South Island ranges. For the next 2 days pressures were still very low to the south and another trough of low pressure reached Cook Strait. Rain was reported in the North Island mainly west of the main ranges but it affected the whole of the South Island, with some considerable falls in south Westland.

A depression developed on the trough over the North Tasman Sea and moved south-eastward across Northland and Bay of Plenty to a position off the East Coast. From the 5th to the 7th rain affected mainly the North Island, with some heavy falls in Auckland, Waikato, Waitomo, Bay of Plenty, Taupo, Gisborne, and Hawke's Bay. Flooding was reported in the lower parts of the Waikato. During the next 2 days the depression moved away and a ridge of high pressure extended over the country from the north, bringing mainly fine weather.

On the 10th and 11th a very deep depression passed far to the south-west and two troughs of low pressure crossed the country. In the very strong north-westerly flow violent gales were reported in Otago, Canterbury, and Wellington, causing considerable damage. More heavy rain fell on the West Coast with lighter falls elsewhere. During the next 2 days a depression developed on the second trough and crossed northern districts of the North Island. Some rain fell over most of the North Island, with considerable falls in Hawke's Bay in the easterlies.

On the 14th the depression moved away and a ridge of high pressure brought improved conditions. However, some rain was still reported in eastern and northern districts of the North Island. On the following day a weak trough of low pressure brought

some rain to the West Coast and Southland. From the 16th to the 18th an anticyclone over and later to the east of the North Island brought settled weather to the whole country, except the West Coast.

During the 19th and 20th a complex depression from the North Tasman Sea crossed northern districts of the North Island. Considerable rain was reported in Northland and Bay of Plenty with some rain also over the remainder of the North Island, while showers affected the West Coast and the Otago and Canterbury coasts. For the next 2 days a deep depression over the South Tasman Sea crossed Southland and Otago, while the associated trough of low pressure brought fairly general rain. In the westerlies there were some considerable falls on the West Coast, and parts of Otago were also affected in this way. Owing to the development of a small depression off the Buller coast, light rain persisted on the 23rd over the North Island and on the east coast of the South Island.

During the 24th and 25th a depression passed eastward close to Southland with an associated trough of low pressure. In the westerlies rain was fairly general, except for most of Otago and Canterbury. On the 2 following days a second depression followed a very similar track, with rain again general, except in Otago and Canterbury, besides parts of Hawke's Bay. Some considerable falls were reported on the West Coast and in some northern districts. On the 28th and 29th this depression moved away to the east of the South Island but a second centre formed off the Westland coast and moved north-eastward. The rain persisted on both days over the North Island but cleared over most of the South Island on the 29th. On the last day of the month a ridge of high pressure extended southward from an anticyclone to the north, bringing mainly fine weather.
