Decision of the Indecent Publications Tribunal

In the matter of the Indecent Publications Act 1963, and in the matter of an application by the Secretary for Justice for a decision in respect of the books *The Lure of Postures* by Sha Kokken, M.D., published by Ikeda Publishing Co., Tokyo, and *Helga and Bernd* by Holger Benson and Thomas Bengh, published by Stephenson Verlag, Flensburg, West Germany.

There was no appearance of the applicant nor of the publisher's representative in New Zealand. A written submission was made by Waverley Publishing Co. Ltd. as representative of the publisher.

DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL

THESE books deal with the technique of sexual intercourse. They use photographs with an explanatory text. They clearly fall into the category described in Decision 200 on the Morgens Toft version of this theme, and in Decision 339 on The Pictorial Guide by Schwenda and Leucher, in that they are serious, dignified, and beautiful in treatment.

Because one element in the rejection by the Tribunal of cruder books on this subject was the fact that the couple in the photographs wore bikinis (Decision 223), it is perhaps necessary to comment further. In both the books now under consideration the two people wear ballet tights. In the case of the German publication this stylises the positions in a way

which we think unobjectionable. In the Japanese book the positions are adopted by each person singly and in the manner of ballet, which gives physical and psychological detachment, and makes the costume entirely suitable if not essential; for this reason, the Tribunal considered making no restriction at all on *The Lure of Postures* but as its nature, purpose, and text are as sexually adult as in the other case we decide it should be classified in the same way.

The Tribunal classifies these books as indecent in the hands of persons under 16 years unless such persons are being instructed by parents or professional advisers.

The Koka Shastra, being the Ratirahashya of Kokkoka and other Mediaeval Indian writings on love, translated and with an introduction by Alex Comfort is a Tandem paperback edition of a work first published by George Allen and Unwin Ltd. in 1964.

Approximately half of this book consists of the first English translation of Kokkoka's 12th century Ratirahashya (secrets of Rati, wife of the love god—the Koka Shastra, or Koka's book) and various other texts. The rest of the work comprises a 30-page preface by W. G. Archer dealing with the discovery of the Ratirahashya by Sir Richard Burton's associate, F. F. Arbuhnot, and its place in Hindu erotic literature, also the translator's own 52-page introduction. Small diagrammatic illustrations of various coital positions are included: these are in no way offensive.

The texts are highly erotic but could not possibly be described as pornographic. The work could offend only persons whose minds were disturbed or persons who consider sexual congress offensive or shameful in any circumstances. The introductions are scholarly and cannot be faulted on the score of taste: the works themselves are largely poetical dissertations on romantic love in the circumstances prescribed and accepted by the society of the period. The pieces chosen reveal both wisdom and essential innocence in that society.

The Tribunal classifies this book as not indecent.

Tariff and Development Board Notice No. 244—Inquiry Concerning Protection for Copper and Copper Alloy Nails

- 1. Following receipt by the Minister of Customs of a report from the Emergency Protection Authority, the Government has accepted the recommendation of the Authority that, pending inquiry and report by the Tariff and Development Board, a temporary duty equal to seveneighths of the amount by which the f.o.b. value is less than \$1.30 per lb be imposed, in addition to the duties already in force, on imports of copper and copper alloy nails from all sources except on those being the manufacture or produce of Australia. In this connection the Tariff provisions in respect of the goods in question, which prior to acceptance of the E.P.A. recommendation were as set out in Schedule A to this notice, have been temporarily amended, effective on 15 October 1971, in the manner indicated in Schedule B. At the same time the goods, which prior to acceptance of the E.P.A. recommendation were provided for in Tariff items 74.14.03 and 74.14.09, were exempted from import licensing.
- 2. In accordance with the provisions of the Tariff and Development Board Act, the Minister of Customs has requested the Board to inquire into and report on what form of protection, if any, is necessary in respect of copper and copper alloy nails at present temporarily classified in Tariff item 74.14.12.
- 3. The Board will, in accordance with its normal procedures, conduct a public hearing in the Boardroom, First Floor, Law Society Building, 26 Waring Taylor Street, Wellington, on Tuesday, 8 February 1972, commencing at 10.30 a.m.
- 4. Any person who intends to tender evidence should lodge, in typewritten form, 14 copies of public evidence and 12 copies of confidential evidence, to be presented under oath at the public hearing, at the Board's office no later than Friday, 21 January 1972. In preparing this evidence the "Notes for Guidance of Witnesses" prepared by the Board may be of assistance. Copies of these notes may be obtained from the Board's office.
