(2) The revocation of the said order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this order.

3. References in this order to metropolitan areas are references to the metropolitan areas described in the Schedule hereto.

APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

4. This order applies with respect to all Californian oranges sold by way of retail in New Zealand.

MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF CALIFORNIAN ORANGES

5. (1) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for Californian oranges to which this order applies shall be:

(a) When sold by a retailer carrying on business in any of the metropolitan areas of Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, or Dunedin, or in any of the Cities or Boroughs of Whangarei, Takapuna, Hamilton, Tauranga, Rotorua, Gisborne, New Plymouth, Stratford, Hawera, Wanganui, Palmerston North, Napier, Hastings, Masterton, Blenheim, Nelson, Greymouth, Timaru, Westport, Oamaru, Balclutha, Gore, or Invercargill—

22 cents per lb.

(b) When sold by a retailer carrying on business elsewhere—

1 lb, 23 cents;
2 lb, 45 cents;
3 lb, 68 cents;
4 lb, 90 cents;
5 lb, \$1.13;
6 lb, \$1.35.

Fractions of a pound shall be calculated at the rate of 23 cents per pound. Quantities in excess of 6 lb. shall be calculated at the rate of 22½ cents per pound.

(2) If in respect of any lot of oranges sold by a retailer the maximum price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause is not an exact number of cents the maximum price of the lot may be computed to the nearest whole cent.

PROVISIONS FOR SPECIAL PRICES

6. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this order, and subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any retailer, may authorise special maximum prices in respect of any Californian oranges to which this order applies where special circumstances exist, or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of oranges, or may relate generally to all Californian oranges to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force.

DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS

7. Every retailer who offers or exposes any Californian oranges for sale in any shop shall keep in a prominent position in such proximity to the oranges to which it relates as to be obviously descriptive thereof, a ticket, placard, or

label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the following particulars:

(a) The retail price per pound of the oranges. Retailers to whom clause 5 (1) (b) of this order applies shall state at least the prices for 1 lb and 2 lb lots.

(b) The word "Californian".

Fractions of a pound shall be calculated at the rate of 19 cents per lb. Quantities in excess of 6 lb shall be calculated at the rate of 18½ cents per lb.

(2) If in respect of any lot of bananas the price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause is not an exact number of cents, the maximum price of the lot shall be computed to the nearest whole cent.

PROVISIONS FOR SPECIAL PRICES

6. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this order, and subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any retailer, may authorise special maximum prices in respect on any Ecuadorian bananas to which this order applies where special circumstances exist, or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of bananas, or may relate generally to all Ecuadorian bananas to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force.

DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS

7. Every retailer who offers or exposes for sale in any shop any Ecuadorian bananas to which this order applies shall keep in a prominent position, in such proximity to the bananas to which it relates as to be obviously in relation thereto, a ticket, placard, or label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the following particulars:

- (a) The retail price per pound of the bananas. Retailers to whom clause 5 (1) (b) of this order applies shall state at least the prices for 1 lb and 2 lb lots.
- (b) The word "Ecuadorian".

NOTES ON THE WEATHER FOR NOVEMBER 1971

General—November was a sunny month marked by an unusually high frequency of north-easterly winds. Farmers found it a good month except that in parts of the North Island, especially eastern districts, it was too wet for the lambs.

Strong gales from a westerly quarter buffeted most of the North Island on the 26th, causing some damage.

Rainfall—Rainfall was above normal over most of the North Island besides most of Otago, Stewart Island, and parts of Fiordland, Nelson, and Marlborough. It was more than double the normal value in eastern Bay of Plenty and around Dunedin.

It was 25 percent drier than normal in North and Central Canterbury and in parts of Buller; also in northern Southland.

Daily falls of up to 160 mm on the 15th caused flooding on the Taieri Plain.

Temperatures—Temperatures were above normal by up to 1°C over the North Island. In the South Island they were a little above normal on the coast and a little below normal inland.

An unusually late fall of snow was reported on the hills in parts of Central Otago and South Canterbury on the 15th, affecting transport over the "Pig Route".

In some areas this was the eighteenth successive month with temperatures warmer than normal; and 1971 is likely to be one of the warmest years on record for New Zealand.

Sunshine—Sunshine was close to or above normal. Departures of 40-80 hours were reported in Westland and also in Wellington and parts of Manawatu. Haast had its highest November sunshine since 1949.

The period from the 2nd to the 12th was particularly sunny and dry in the South Island besides southern and eastern districts of the North Island, under the influence of an anticyclone centred near the Chatham Islands.

Weather Sequence—At the beginning of November a weak cold front crossed the South Island while a shallow depression was off the South Westland coast. Rain was reported in Southland, Fiordland, South Westland, and part of Otago.

On the 2nd a belt of high pressure covered most of New Zealand and it soon moved away eastward, remaining almost stationary near the Chatham Islands up to the 12th. This 11-day period was generally warm; and it was dry over the South Island as well as southern and eastern districts of the North Island. Most of the rain which fell in other parts of the North Island was due to the north-easterlies freshening at times as depressions passed well to the north. The main periods of rain in these districts were from the 4th to the 8th and on the 11th and 12th.

From the 13th to the 15th a depression off the coast of New South Wales moved across the Tasman Sea and deepened, while a trough of low pressure moved north-eastward over the country. Rain started in the south and spread northward, with cooler

temperatures. On the 15th a small secondary depression formed off the coast of Otago with heavy rain there, resulting in flooding. In the easterlies the weather cleared on the West Coast. During the next 2 days the main depression crossed the North Island with further rain there, while the weather improved slowly over most of the South Island. With the depression to the east on the 18th, rain persisted over the North Island besides Nelson and Marlborough.

From the 19th to the 21st pressures remained low over the North Island and to the east, while a ridge of high pressure passed over Campbell Island. In the cool south-easterlies rain persisted over the North Island and Marlborough, while a few showers were also reported on the Canterbury coast. On the following day a small depression moved southward along the west coast of both islands and trough of low pressure crossed the country. Rain still covered the whole of the North Island and now also western and northern districts of the South Island.

During the 23rd and 24th pressures were low to the south and a depression with its associated trough of low pressure crossed the

south Tasman Sea and moved on to Southland. Rain was reported west of the ranges in both islands. On the next day a depression over the north Tasman Sea moved towards New Zealand, deepening rapidly, and it crossed the country north of Cook Strait on the 26th. In the North Island the weather was wet with strong gales in most districts, while rain also covered the greater part of the South Island.

For the last 4 days of the month pressures were high over and to the north of Northland, while a series of deep depressions passed far to the south and the associated troughs of low pressure crossed New Zealand. In the westerlies rain was reported on the West Coast and on the Southland coast, and light falls also affected some western districts of the North Island on the 27th and 28th.
